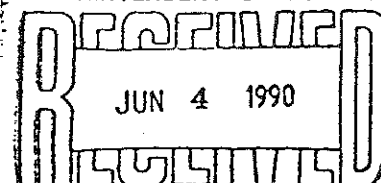

POLICY
4118.232

The Board of Education of the Township of Brick has established as a standard of conduct strict prohibition of the unlawful possession, use or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol or being under the influence of illicit drugs and alcohol on school premises or as part of any school activity.

Disciplinary sanctions (consistent with local, state and federal law) will be imposed on school employees who violate the standard of conduct. Employees may be subject to completion of an appropriate rehabilitation program, reprimand, suspension, fine, increment withholding, dismissal and referral for prosecution.

District substance abuse counselors are available to employees for alcohol and drug counseling and to provide information regarding rehabilitation centers. Brick Counseling and Referral Services is an out of district contact providing substance abuse services. A copy of the standards of conduct and disciplinary sanctions shall be distributed at the beginning of each school year.
