The Brick Township Board of Education held a Special Meeting at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 25, 1991 in the Administration Building, 101 Hendrickson Avenue, Brick, New Jersey.

Present were: Mrs. Russell, Mr. Bizzarro, Mrs. Benton, Mr. Celentano, Mr. Leahy and Mr. Pannucci.

Also present: Dr. Aragona, Mr. Stutts and Mr. Collins.

**SUNSHINE
LAW**

Mr. Stutts announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted on June 18, 1991 as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, Municipal Clerk and Brick Town News.

MTG. HELD This meeting was held to address staffing for Camp TO ADDRESS Beadleston, which was to open on June 27, 1991. Dr. Aragona reviewed Personnel-teaching items involving Camp Beadleston. **CAMP BEAD ONLY.**

REPORT ON Mr. Bizzarro asked for a report on whether facilities at Camp Zehnder had been brought up to what would be considered **FACILITIES** accessible for handicapped. Dr. Richardson explained that **AT ZEHNDER** the Y.M.C.A. had improved fixtures and bathrooms. He provided pictures showing new bathroom facilities, wider doorways, etc. Dr. Richardson stated that he was recommending that the pool portion of Camp Zehnder be used for Camp Beadleston.

EXPLAIN Mr. Pannucci explained that because of the danger of Lyme **MOVE FROM** disease and following a recommendation from the State **ZEHNDER TO** Department of Health, it had been decided to hold Camp **MEM. HS** Beadleston in air conditioned rooms at Memorial High School and bus the children to Camp Zehnder for the pool portion of the program.

AUDIENCE Much discussion was held by the audience members regarding the pros and cons of moving Camp Beadleston from the Camp Zehnder site.

MOTION TO Motion was made by Mrs. Benton, seconded by Mr. Leahy and **APPROVE** carried unanimously by roll call vote to approve items (a **HIRING** & b) under Personnel-teaching and item (a) under Auxiliary **STAFF FOR** as follows: **CAMP BEADLESTON**
