MR. BIZZARRO**SPEAKS****AGAINST****ITEM (G)**

Mr. Bizzarro asked to speak against item (g), which was to authorize the Administration to fill vacancies in teaching and non-teaching positions between meeting dates and prior to opening of school in September. He quoted Statute Title 18A:27-1 which states that no teaching staff member shall be appointed except by recorded roll call majority vote of the full membership of the Board. He felt that Administration can appoint personnel in emergency situations, but Board does not have right to vote against State Statute. Mr. Bizzarro asked for a legal opinion of his point of order. The attorney stated that to leave this item on the Agenda would not be in violation of State Statute. Dr. Aragona explained that Administration only uses this authority when time is short when vying with another school district for a potential teacher. The Board would be informed of the hiring at the next Board Meeting.

Mr. Pannucci asked for a vote on item (g). Mr. Bizzarro stated that he was challenging that decision.
