Data Processing Programmer/Systems Analyst

DEFINITION:

Will work under the supervision of the Director of Data Processing and in his absence be responsible for all phases of the systems, programming and operations of the Data Processing Department.

EXAMPLES OF WORK:

Maintain existing computer software currently operating in the Data Processing Department.

Perform system studies of existing clerical duties.

Prepare reports presenting options to automate existing systems with new or updated electronic systems.

Write computer software for the district mainframe computer using the programming language R.P.G.

Write new and update existing computer procedures using the System/36 Operator Control Language.

Thorough knowledge of the System/36 SDA, DFU, and Sort utilities.

Write documentation to explain and substantiate all phases of automated systems.

Write user manuals to explain and instruct terminal and computer operators.

Have working knowledge of IBM-DOS.

Have knowledge of interactive personal computer data base languages.

Ability to work with district employees in both the analytical capacity (for existing manual systems) and instructional capacity (for teaching new applications).

Ability to manage Data Processing Department personnel in the absence of the Data Processing Director.

Ability to trouble shoot existing systems in the absence of the Data Processing Director.

REQUIREMENTS:

Education: Graduation from a four year course at a college of recognized standing.

Note: Candidates who do not meet the above educational requirement may substitute additional work experience as directed below on a year for year basis.

Experience: Five years experience involving programming, systems analysis and documentation.
