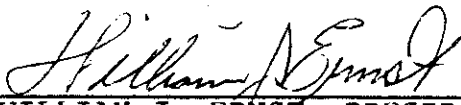

THE BRICK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE TRANSPORT WORKERS UNION HEREBY AGREE ON THE BELOW STATED LANGUAGE TO BE ADDED AS AN ADDENDUM TO THE EXISTING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BRICK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE TRANSPORT WORKERS UNION OF AMERICA, AFL-CIO, LOCAL 225 BRANCH 4 - JULY 1, 1994 TO JUNE 30, 1997.

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION WILL EMPLOY NO MORE THAN 15 "LESS THAN EIGHT (8) HOUR" BUS DRIVERS WHO WILL WORK LESS THAN 30 HOURS PER WEEK. THESE SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS WILL RECEIVE EMPLOYEE ONLY MANAGED HEALTH CARE BENEFITS TO INCLUDE HEALTH, PRESCRIPTION AND DENTAL, UNLESS SUCH DRIVER IS ELIGIBLE FOR TRADITIONAL COVERAGE WITH FULL UNDERSTANDING THAT ONLY SINGLE COVERAGE IS PROVIDED FOR DRIVERS WORKING LESS THAN 30 HOURS. THE EMPLOYEE WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR FULL FAMILY HEALTH CARE BENEFITS WHEN THEIR WORKWEEK IS 30 HOURS OR MORE.

THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT WILL INCREASE THESE LESS THAN 8 HOUR RUNS, WHEN PRACTICAL, BEFORE ADDING TO OTHER RUNS.
