Buildings & Grounds

B&G

- Mr. Woska, Chairperson for Buildings & Grounds Committee, thanked Mayor Scarpelli and the Township for repairing the pavement outside Brick Township High School. This was approximately a \$10,000-\$15,000 savings for the school district.

Mr. Woska gave a presentation and update on the proposed plan, recreational field development projects.

1. Veterans Complex - two new fields. Undeveloped land behind soccer and baseball fields, working on proposal to set up another multi-purpose field and a softball field. There was an illustration of the layout.
2. At Lake Riviera Middle School, there is field reconstruction going on; creating a multi-purpose field in that area.
3. District Television Studio - near completion.
4. Brick Township High School Window Replacement Project - completed.
5. Laurelton School Renovation Project - completed.
6. Herbertsville Classroom Project - structure has been delivered and the modulars will be put up over the weekend.

Dr. Nicastro presented Auxiliary agenda items (a-f). Next week a representative will be at the Board Meeting to give an overview of Alpha Delta Kappa, which Brick Township is an active Chapter.

Special Committee Reports

- Mrs. Kelly had been approached by parents of Veterans Memorial Middle School seeking an additional coach for their track team. There are 80 students with 1 coach.

Mrs. Kelly requested Board to look at the feasibility and cost of introducing girls field hockey and spring track teams at the middle schools.
