WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Toms River Schools has adopted its 1987-88 School Calendar, and
WHEREAS, the School Calendar contains a Spring Break covering the dates of April 1 - 8, and
WHEREAS, the date of the Annual School Election is scheduled for April 5, 1988 (Title 18A:14-2), and
WHEREAS, Title 18A:14-2.1 allows the Commissioner of Education to make adjustments to the school budget and election calendar as necessary, if the date coincides with a period of religious observance, and
WHEREAS, it is felt that the Spring Break, which also includes the dates of Passover, will involve many school districts in Ocean County and the State of New Jersey, now therefore be it
RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Toms River Schools forward this Resolution to the Commissioner of Education to establish an Annual School Election date other than the one now specified in Title 18A:14-2, and be it further
RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the New Jersey School Boards and the Ocean County School Boards Associations.
