Mr. Woska and Mr. Puleio told the audience that the Architect and Construction Manager will be making a Power Point presentation at the meeting on the 19th showing the progress of all construction projects. There are ten projects, nine of which are under construction. The site will be cleared early next week for the Enrichment Center which is going to be built next to the Administration Building. Mr. DeLuca asked about the progress at Brick Memorial High School. Mr. Puleio replied that on Monday, GPU is coming out to review a power situation. The power will have to be shut down at the school for about 4 or 5 hours. Once that work is completed, the project will get back on schedule.
