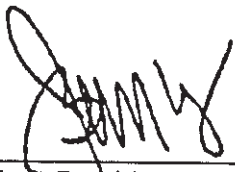
AGREEMENT

The Provisional Teaching Program (for both traditional and alternate route teachers) has been in place in the Brick Township School District since 1985. During recent years, the Department of Education has provided the monies required for the mentoring fees.

Last year, the New Jersey State Department of Education decided to cease payments for the second-year program. This past August, the Department notified districts that they would also be stopping payment for the first-year mentors.

Due to the lateness in receiving this notice, as well as the burden placed on our new teachers, the mentoring fees will be subsidized by the School District from Title II grant funds. This subsidy would only be for the 2002-2003 school year. New teachers will assume the responsibility for any mentoring costs after the 2002-2003 school year.
