The Brick Township Board of Education conducted a Pre-Agenda Meeting on September 11, 2003, at 7:42 p.m. in the Auditorium at Brick Township High School, 346 Chambers Bridge Road, Brick, New Jersey.

Dr. Boyan opened the meeting with a salute to the flag and a moment of silence.

Mr. Puleio announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted on September 6, 2003 as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, Municipal Clerk.

Mr. Pannucci presented Curriculum and Instruction, which only included informational items regarding home schooling.

At this time Mr. Bendokas noted that some of the new appointees were in the audience. Mrs. Ceres introduced each one and gave a brief outline of their experiences.

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Mr. DeLuca presented Personnel Non-Teaching items, item (a) through (f) for approval next week. Dr. Boyan asked for any comments or questions from the Board and then the audience. Mr. Sandy Scott, 237 Oklahoma Drive, addressed the Board saying that the payment of paraprofessionals is too low, especially those paraprofessionals who work with children with Autism, and asked the Board to do something about it. Mrs. Jean Scott, 3119 Pocahontas Avenue, Pt. Pleasant, spoke saying that she was hired as a substitute paraprofessional last September to work in the Autistic class, received special training for this work, and was promised a full time position if she waited. She has not been given a full time position and substitute pay is too low. Mr. Pannucci agreed that the pay for paraprofessionals and substitute teachers is ridiculous.

Mr. Woska presented an update under Buildings & Grounds reporting that the Educational Enrichment Center is getting to the point of interior work, as well as the Brick Memorial project.

Mr. Hrycenko presented Auxiliary items (a) - (c) for approval next week. Dr. Boyan asked for any comments or questions from the Board and then the audience. There were none.

Dr. Boyan commented on the situation of the bus stop at Cumberland Drive and Baywood Boulevard, saying that the Administration petitioned the Town Council to hire a Crossing Guard to assist with the safety of the students at that stop.

In response to questions from the last meeting, Mr. Hrycenko reported in answer to Mr. Talty's question, that 27% of the new teachers hired were from Brick Township.

Dr. Boyan asked the Public if anyone would like to make comments on Policies at this time. There were none.

Dr. Boyan opened the meeting for Public Comment. Mrs. Sharon Kight, 148 Marilyn Drive, presented a situation to the Board regarding her son and the rule that a volunteer coach must have sixty college credits. She expressed disappointment that he is having difficulty paying back to the Program from which he gained so much.
