Dr. Seidenberger took this opportunity to wish Dr. Kasyan well in his new position, thanking him for his many years in the District. He also wished Todd Flora the best in his new position with the State Department.

Mr. DeLuca presented Personnel **Non-Teaching** items, (a) through (g). Dr. Boyan asked for any comments or questions from the Board and then the public. Kathy Williams, 579 Midwood Drive, spoke of problems she has been having regarding her son and the lack of a speech teacher to fill the hours outlined in his IEP. Dr. Seidenberger explained that speech teachers are very hard to find. The Administration was actively looking for them over the summer. One was hired tonight and the Administration is negotiating with another. Dr. Seidenberger said that every effort will be made to make up the time lost while the position has been vacant. Mrs. Williams also asked if there is a chance that her son would be transferred to the new Educational Enrichment Center. The Administration assured her that this was not a possibility. Mrs. Joyce Neafsey, 116 Albert Street, said that her autistic son has done very well at the PLC, with the verbal behavior program and was returned to the PLC because the elementary school was not prepared to continue the program. She asked the Administration and Board of Education to consider more funding for aides for autistic children. She is concerned because there are no programs for older autistic children and her son is getting older. Mrs. Brenda Calderone, 445 Austin Avenue, parent of a 6 year old autistic child agreed that more paraprofessionals and teachers are needed for this program and that the salary for paraprofessionals is dismal. Mr. Pannucci stated that progress is being made in increasing the numbers of paraprofessionals.
