

NOTICE OF SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING OF ELECTION of the School District of the TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey, on TUESDAY, October 22, 1957.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the legal voters of the School District of the Township of Brick, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey, that a special meeting or election of the legal voters of said District will be held on Tuesday, the 22nd day of October, 1957, at 4:00 o'clock P. M. prevailing time.

The polls will remain open until 9:00 o'clock P.M. and as much longer as may be necessary to permit all the legal voters then present to vote and to cast their ballots.

The meeting or election will be held and all the legal voters of the School District will vote at the respective polling places stated below.

At the said meeting or election, the following proposal will be submitted:

PROPOSAL

Resolved that the Board of Education of the Township of Brick, in the County of Ocean, is hereby authorized:

(a) To acquire by purchase or condemnation as a site for the new schoolhouse the plot of land located in the school district on the westerly side of Midstreams Road containing approximately 14.24 acres, and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stone monument at the third and southwesterly corner of a tract of land containing 482 acres and conveyed by Lewis Johnson and James Johnson to Riley Johnson by deed dated August 29, 1887 and recorded in the Ocean County Clerk's Office in Book 156 of Deeds, at Page 424 and running thence (1) by magnetic bearings of A.D. 1957, north 26 degrees 19 minutes west, 462.14 feet to a stone monument; thence (2) north 73 degrees 53 minutes 10 seconds east, 1363.22 feet to a stake in the westerly line of Midstreams Road; (3) along said westerly line, south 27 degrees 50 minutes 30 seconds east, 460.41 feet to a stake; and thence (4) south 73 degrees 43 degrees 10 seconds west, 1374.96 feet to the point and place of beginning, and to construct on said plot of land a new schoolhouse, purchase the school furniture and other equipment necessary therefor and improve the said plot of land, and to expend for all of the aforesaid, including incidental expenses, not exceeding \$470,000; and

(b) To issue bonds of the school district for said purposes in the principal amount of \$470,000, thus increasing the existing deficit in the borrowing margin of the said Township of Brick previously available for other improvements raising its net debt to \$1,653,996.70 beyond such borrowing margin.

The polling places for the said meeting or election and their respective polling districts (described by reference to the election districts used at the last General Election in said municipality) are established and have been designated as follows and no person shall vote at said meeting or election elsewhere than at the polling place designated for the voters of the polling district in which he or she resides.

POLLING DISTRICT No. 1

Polling place at the Osbornville School at Osbornville in the School District, for legal voters residing within General Election Districts Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11.

POLLING DISTRICT No. 2

Polling place at the Laurelton School at Laurelton in the School District, for legal voters residing within General Elections District Nos. 3, 4, 5.

POLLING DISTRICT No. 3

Polling place at the Herbertsville School at Herbertsville in the School District, for legal voters residing within General Election District Nos. 1, 2.

Motion was made by Mr. Sendzik, seconded by Mrs. Newall to adopt the Program of Studies for the Junior-Senior High School as outlined in bulletin received by all Board Members.

Mr. Griffith suggested the parking of all school buses not parked in Board of Education garages, at the Municipal Building on their parking lot. This move was approved by the Board because of the stealing of gas from these parked buses. Discussion was held with regard to providing funds in the 1958-1959 Budget for playground equipment for the schools. Mr. Griffith stated that nothing has been provided for ten years and he feels it is time something was done. The raising of funds for this equipment by the P.T.A.'s was also discussed and the Board feels that it is not the duty of the P.T.A. to raise funds for this type of project that it is primarily up to the Board of Education itself. The by-laws of the P.T.A. states that the P.T.A. should not purchase equipment.
