Buildings and Grounds Item (a) was held until after Executive Session.

Buildings & Grounds Informational:

Dr. Normandia explained that he, Dr. Nicastro, Mr. Yezzi, Architect and the middle school principals visited another school district where modular units had been installed. They were very impressed. You would not have known the modular unit was not a part of the main building.

Dr. Normandia requested approval to move on these modular units as quickly as possible. The timeline would be Board approval this evening for submission of specifications of two permanent modular units for each middle school. This would enable administration to submit specifications to the New Jersey Department of Education for their approval. Bid awards will move ahead on July 15, 1995 with occupancy scheduled for December 1, 1995 at both middle schools. Dr. Normandia went on to explain that if the Board approves this plan, new staff members would be hired on September 1st for those classrooms. During the summer of 1995, students would be identified that would be moving to those units as well as the staff that would be moving to those buildings. During the first months of school, staff would work with those students. There would be cooperative teaching so the new teachers would meet, grade and teach those students prior to the transition.

Mr. Mercer explained that though having some reservations about cost and placement, his feeling is to go ahead and submit the specifications to Trenton.

Mr. Mueller felt that more avenues should be explored.

Money was dedicated to purchase 100 trees and shrubs for a project at Drum Point School. Mr. Mercer explained that he met with the Township and BTMUA personnel and there is a possibility of purchasing 300 trees and shrubs for the same amount of money. That money would then be reinvested in other sites in the Township. All the labor is provided for by voluntary services. We have until the June meeting to decide if we are interested. There would be no additional cost to the Board.
