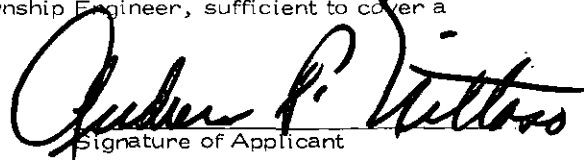

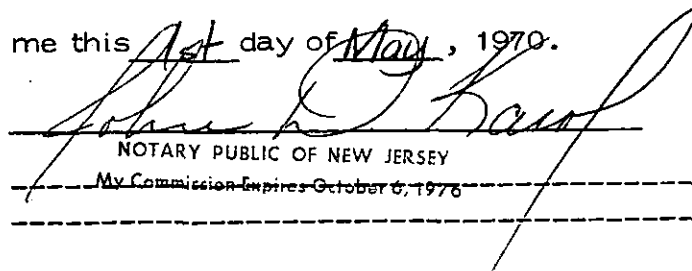

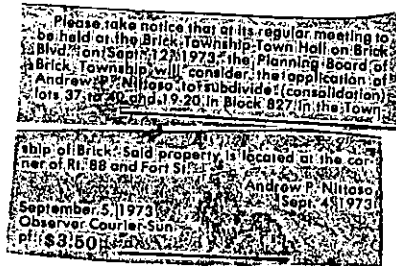

1. Ocean County Planning Board approval is lacking.
2. Certification that the applicant or company in which the applicant has an interest does not own nor has contracted to purchase abutting land.
3. The appropriate zone districts are not indicated.
4. Curbs and sidewalks are not indicated along Route 88 or Fort Street. Curbs shall be located on the property line on Route 88 and sidewalks shall be located 4' from the curb face (street side) and be 5' wide. Sidewalks on Fort Street shall be located 4' from the curb face and shall be 4' wide.

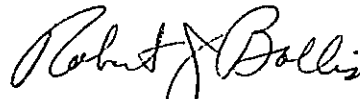
