New Jersey Transit Corporation ("NJ TRANSIT") is in receipt of your request pursuant to the Open Public Records Act, N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, et seq. ("OPRA"), dated January 8, 2024, and subsequently clarified by email dated January 18, 2024, seeking the following:

Under the OPRA and the common law right of access, please provide copies of all BWC camera recordings from NJ transit responses to the Edison train station and Edison station parking lot 3 on December 31, 2023. to January 2nd 2024 Thank you.

NJ transit called the Edison police on 12/31/2023 or 01/01/2024

I request all NJ transit police reports on that call or all calls to the Edison police department to trespass or have persons removed from the Edison train station or bus stop on these dates. (the "Request").

Attached please find the CAD report and calls from NJTPD to the Edison Police Department. This record has been redacted to remove personal identifying information. This record has also been redacted to protect security measures which, if disclosed, would create a risk to the safety of persons, property, electronic data or software. See N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1.

Please be advised this is a partial response to your OPRA request. The portion of the Request seeking body worn camera footage remains under review. According to our records, the current due date for this request is April 26, 2024, as per our office's April 5, 2024, letter.
