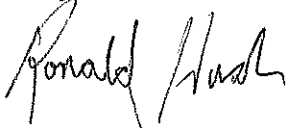
It is with regret that I am writing to inform you of my decision to resign my position on the New Brunswick Board of Education effective January 16, 2019.

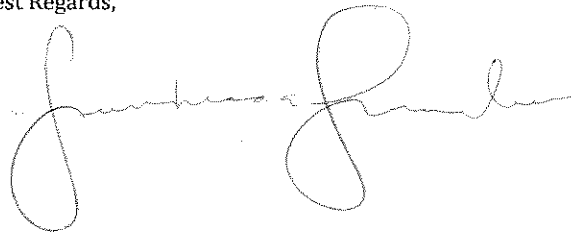
Dear Ms. Sadowski:
