Dear Ciaran Johnson,

The Boonton Township Police Department received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on November 25, 2024. Please accept this letter as my response pursuant to OPRA.

Your request seeks the following records:

"Incident reports including officer narrative that have been coded as a fight /dispute from 11/18/2024 to 11/22/2024."

I am unable to complete your request since there are no responsive records.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Boonton Township Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
