The Delaware River Port Authority (DRPA) has retained the South Jersey Transit Partners (SJTP) to perform Concept Development Engineering Design Services for the Glassboro-Camden Light Rail Project. The Glassboro-Camden Line Project (GCL) is an 18-mile light rail transit system that will operate primarily on existing Conrail right-of-way from the City of Camden's Walter Rand Transportation Center, through Camden and Gloucester Counties, terminating in the Borough of Glassboro. The proposed GCL will traverse eleven communities including:

- City of Camden
- Gloucester City
- Brooklawn Borough
- Westville Borough
- City of Woodbury
- Woodbury Heights Borough
- Wenonah Borough
- Deptford Township
- Mantua Township
- Pitman Borough
- and the Borough of Glassboro.

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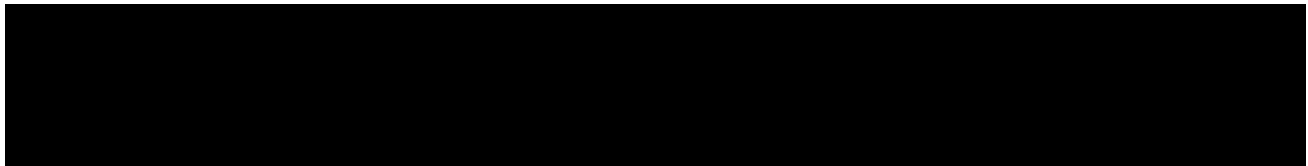

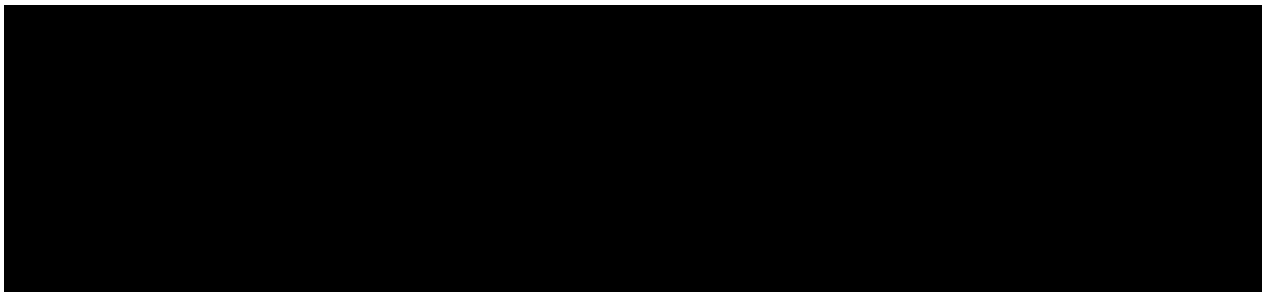

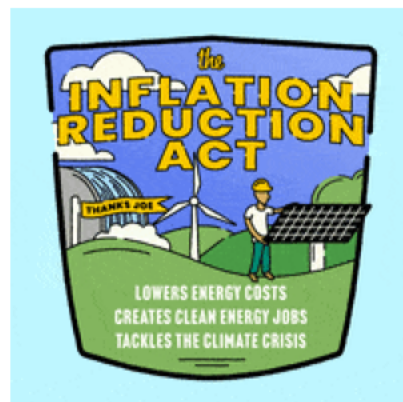
