Re: OPRA Request dated November 2, 2020

To whom it may concern:

The Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on November 2, 2020. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is November 13, 2020. This response is being provided to you within said seven (7) business days.

You requested the following information as outlined in your email:

1. A dated copy of the Letter of Resignation of Brian Chewcaskie, former commissioner and chairman at Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (NBCUA).
2. All written forms of communication from Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, including former chairman Brian Chewcaskie, with the Borough of Oakland from January 1st, 2017 to December 31st, 2020.
3. All written forms of communication between NBCUA, including former chairman Brian Chewcaskie, and Boswell Engineering regarding the Borough of Oakland from January 1st, 2017 to December 31st, 2020.
4. All written forms of communication between NBCUA, including former chairman Brian Chewcaskie, and attorney John Napolitano from January 1st, 2015 to December 31st, 2020.
5. All written forms of communication from NBCUA, including former chairman Brian Chewcaskie, and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection regarding the Borough of Oakland from January 1st, 2017 to December 31st, 2020.

A follow up email was sent to amend the request as follows:

"I would like to change the expanse of time on each of these above-stated OPRA request statements. Each should be explored from January 1st, 2012 and end December, 31st 2020 (with knowledge the year has yet to end)."

Your request requires additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to fulfill due to the extensive time period covered by the request. At the present time, it is anticipated the Authority shall be able to provide the requested information by December 4, 2020.

Kindly respond in writing with your acceptance of the extended deadline date. At that time, we also anticipate that we will be able to provide you with the estimated charges, if any.
