The Wall Township Board of Education is in receipt of your emailed request that is dated November 19, 2024, wherein you requested records under OPRA as follows:

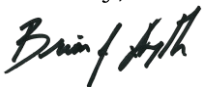
“This is a request for public records made under OPRA and the common law right of access.
Kindly provide: Wall BOE Executive session minutes for September and October 2024.”

In response, please know that you previously requested the executive session minutes for September 2024, along with other records, on October 17, 2024, and this office provided responsive records on November 1, 2024. Please reference our prior correspondence.

Your request for Executive Session minutes for October 2024, requires an extension to time to allow for the review and redaction, if any, of portions of the requested records that is to be shielded under OPRA. Please know that we anticipate being able to provide a follow up response by Friday, November 6, 2024.

OPRA. If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
