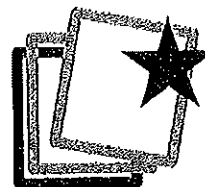

- ☒ "a public agency has a responsibility and an obligation to safeguard from public access a citizen's personal information with which it has been entrusted when disclosure thereof would violate the citizen's reasonable expectation of privacy."

Burnett v. County of Bergen, 198 N.J. 408 (2009). Without ambiguity, the court held that the privacy provision "is neither a preface nor a preamble." Rather, "the very language expressed in the privacy clause reveals its substantive nature; it does not offer reasons why OPRA was adopted, as preambles typically do; instead, it focuses on the law's implementation." "Specifically, it imposes an obligation on public agencies to protect against disclosure of personal information which would run contrary to reasonable privacy interests."

REQUEST FOR RECORDS UNDER THE COMMON LAW

Note that any challenge to a denial of a request for records under the common law cannot be made to the Government Records Council, as the Government Records Council only has jurisdiction to adjudicate challenges to denials of OPRA requests. A challenge to the denial of access under the common law can be made by filing an action in Superior Court.

1. All "government records" as defined in N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 are subject to public access under the Open Public Records Act ("OPRA"), unless specifically exempt.
2. A request for access to a government record under OPRA must be in writing, hand-delivered, mailed, transmitted electronically, or otherwise conveyed to the appropriate custodian. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(g). In accordance with OPRA, custodians will generally have seven (7) business days to respond, unless:

- The requestor seeks "immediate access" records as outlined in N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(e); where the custodian must respond "immediately" disclosing responsive records not to exceed twenty-four (24) months old.
- The requestor seeks information required to be disclosed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-3(b), where the custodian must respond disclosing the information within twenty-four (24) hours or as soon as practical;
- The requestor is seeking records for a "commercial purpose" as defined in N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1, where the response time frame is fourteen (14) business days, but the custodian shall notify the requestor of the additional time within seven (7) business days. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(l). However, the response time frame can be reduced to seven (7) business days upon payment of no more than two times the cost to produce the responsive records.
- The requestor is seeking records requiring review for compliance with "Daniel's Law" (N.J.S.A. 47:1B-1, et seq.), where the response time frame is fourteen (14) business days, but the custodian shall notify the requestor of the additional time within seven (7) business days. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(l).
- Fire district employing one or fewer full-time employees serving as custodians may add seven (7) business days to the seven (7) or fourteen (14) business day response time frames.

The applicable response time does not commence until the custodian receives the request form. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(h). If you submit the request form to any other officer or employee, the recipient must either forward the request to the appropriate custodian or direct you to the appropriate custodian. Id.

3. Requestors are not required to use this OPRA request form; however, a written equivalent not containing the form requirements of N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(f) and N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(g) may be denied by a custodian.
4. Requestors may submit requests anonymously. A request submitted anonymously shall not be considered incomplete. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(f). If you elect not to identify yourself accurately or provide an accurate address, e-mail address, or telephone number, the custodian is not required to respond until you reappear before the custodian seeking a response to the original request. Further, anonymous requestors are prohibited from filing a complaint with either the GRC or the Courts. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-6.
5. The fees for duplication of a "government record" in printed form are listed on page 1 of this form. The custodian will notify you of any special service charges or other additional charges authorized by State law or regulation before processing your request. Payment shall be made by cash, check or money order payable to the responding agency.
6. You may be charged a prepayment or deposit when a request for copies exceeds \$5.00. The custodian will contact you and advise you of any deposit requirements. You agree to pay the balance due upon delivery of the records.
7. Under OPRA, a custodian must deny access to a person who has been convicted of an indictable offense in New Jersey, any other state, or the United States, and who is seeking government records containing personal information pertaining to the person's victim or the victim's family. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-2.2. This includes anonymous requests for said information.
8. By law, the responding agency must notify you that it grants or denies a request for access to government records within applicable response time frame after the custodian receives the request. If the record requested is in storage, the custodian will advise you within seven (7) or fourteen (14) business days after receipt of the request when the record can be made available and the estimated cost for reproduction within no more than twenty-one (21) business days from date of notification. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(l).
9. You may be denied access to a government record if your request would substantially disrupt agency operations and the custodian is unable to reach a reasonable solution with you. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(g).
10. If the custodian is unable to comply with your request for access to a government record, they will indicate the specific bases for denial on the request form or other written correspondence and send it to you.
11. Except as otherwise provided by law or by agreement with the requester, if the custodian fails to respond to you in writing within seven (7) or fourteen (14) business days of receiving a request, the failure to respond is a deemed denial of your request. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(g); N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(l).
12. If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) or fourteen (14) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the responding agency to deny access. At your option, you may either: 1) institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey; or 2) file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County. Questions regarding the GRC's Denial of Access Complaint process can be directed to the GRC toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at PO Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at Government.Records@dca.nj.gov, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can answer general inquiries about OPRA.

On 6/28/2025, at approximately 2015 hours, I (Ptl. Batolone #402) responded to 130 Cherry Tree Farm Rd for an [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] when exiting my vehicle, I was met by Holly Willis (caller) who stated that her husband Richard Willis [REDACTED] (arrested) was no longer on location. I then acquired a vehicle description of the vehicle Mr. Willis was operating. Ms. Willis stated the vehicle was a Black Honda Element, which matched the same vehicle I observed leaving the above address.

As a result, I entered my patrol vehicle and attempted to locate the vehicle (NJ Reg YCZ29J) in the nearby area. At this time, I was unable to locate the vehicle. Therefore, I returned to the above address to question Ms. Willis where Mr. Willis could potentially be going. Ms. Willis informed me that Mr. Willis typically goes to Sandy Hook or in the Highlands area to watch the sunset. As a result, I informed County Dispatch to notify the surrounding Police Departments to be on the lookout the Mr. Willis's vehicle. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] r. Willis did not have any intentions to harm himself, and she was not concerned that Mr. Willis may have any medical episodes.

I then asked Ms. Willis if she was able to contact Mr. Willis via telephone in attempt to locate him. When trying to do so, she was unable to make contact with Mr. Willis at this time. At this time, I cleared the scene to respond to another incident (25MT23855) due to there being no medical emergency at this time.

Upon arrival, I observed Mr. Willis's vehicle parked in the grass area of Countryside Park, and observed Mr. Willis walking on the front property of 120 Cherry Tree Farm Rd. It should be noted that the front lawn of this address was enclosed by a wooden fence. When making contact with Mr. Willis, I asked him why he was walking on another persons private property. Mr. Willis responded that he was walking on the front lawn of 120 Cherry Tree Farm Rd. in attempt to avoid Law Enforcement contact.

I then began to notice redness in Mr. Willis's face, and Mr. Willis swaying slightly side to side. I asked Mr. Willis if he had consumed any alcoholic beverages and he stated that he did not. As a result, [REDACTED] g sluggishly, and slightly dragging his feet. Therefore, I grabbed the right arm of Mr. Willis to ensure that he does not fall. While walking, I was able to detect a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Mr. Willis.

At this time, Mr. Willis attempted to leave the above scene and return to his residence. I informed Mr. Willis that he was not free to leave due to an active investigation taking place. Mr. Willis continued to attempt to walk away from the scene. As a result, I stepped in front of Mr. Willis and informed him numerous times that he was not free to leave due to an active investigation taking place. Mr. Willis then proceed to become verbally aggressive towards me, specifically by using profanity. Mr. Willis then started to walk in my direction when I informed him to maintain his distance several times. Mr. Willis continued to step closer towards me.

At this time, Mr. Willis was placed under arrest for violation 2C:29-1A. Mr. Willis was also placed under arrest for violation 2C:18-3B(3) and violation 39:4-50. Mr. Willis was handcuffed (double locked) and subject was searched incident to arrest which yielded negative additional contraband.

When placed under arrest, [REDACTED]

Upon arrival to RMC, Mr. Willis refused to provide a blood sample regarding the violation of 39:4-50. Reference Ptl. Librie's #397 supplement for further details.

Mr. Willis was then processed and placed on summons number S 1331 2025 000364 for both violation 2c;29-1A and 2C;18-3B(3). Mr. Willis was served with all summons related to this incident.

On 6/29/2025, I, Ptl. Librie #397, was working township-wide DWI patrol. I was advised by Ptl. Bartolone #402, who was at this address for an [REDACTED] that there was a possible intoxicated driver on scene.

I began to make my way to the scene, however prior to my arrival, Ptl. Bartolone stated that he had a male subject, later identified as Richard Willis (DOB: [REDACTED], under arrest and [REDACTED]. Ptl. Bartolone was accompanying Mr. Willis and [REDACTED]. At this point, I re-routed to Middletown Township Police Headquarters to retrieve the potential Liability paperwork, as well as a blood test kit to bring to the hospital.

While at Headquarters, I was advised by Sgt. Colfer #305 that Ptl. Bartolone had asked Mr. Willis if he would consent to a blood draw, to which he responded, "No." I then reached out to County Dispatch to have an on call Assistant Prosecutor contact me in reference to applying for a blood draw warrant. Bartolone and Mr. Willis. AP Layton also advised me to prepare a Letter of Preservation in reference to the toxicology results, and to provide it to the Charge Nurse at the Emergency Room.
