Warrant #Q415841 was issued on 12/16/19 by the honorable Judge James P. Hoebich of New Brunswick. The warrant was issued for failure to appear in reference to a violation of N.J.S.A. 39:4-50 with bail set at \$1000 and a 10% option. We arrived on scene and met with Tristin. I advised her of the warrant. Her boyfriend, 22 yr old, Reise Powell stated that he will respond to police headquarters to post her bail. I secured her in handcuffs (Double Locked) and conducted a search incident to arrest. I transported Tristin to headquarters.

Upon our arrival I escorted her through the rear entrance and into the processing room. Reise arrived at headquarters and provided me with \$100 cash. I completed a bail receipt (B011430) and a bail recognition form. Copies of the bail receipt and bail recognition form were provided to Tristin and Reise. Tristin was advised to contact New Brunswick Municipal court. While speaking with Tristin she reported that her ex-boyfriend has been calling her from Ocean County Jail in violation of a final restraining order. She was escorted to interview room #1 pending further investigation (Reference Case #19- 38105). I placed the \$100 cash, bail receipt and bail recognition form in an envelope and placed it in the court bin. I submitted a copy of the warrant and bail recognition form to records. There is no further police information at this time.

On Wednesday, February 3, 2021, at approximately 2110 hours, Officer Robert Duffy #63 and I responded to 149 Station Drive in response to Robert Scheiner's (will refer to as Robert) report of his daughter, Tristin Scheiner (will refer to as Tristin), being assaulted by her ex-boyfriend, Dennis Tomala-Averos (will refer to as Dennis). Robert reported Dennis fled the scene after the assault.

I was met at the driveway by Tristin who was crying hysterically and her father, Robert. Tristin reported her ex-boyfriend, Dennis, whom she has a child in common had punched and kicked her. Tristin reported Dennis was at her home to visit their son, (will refer to as (2yoa)). Tristin reported she and Dennis were in her bedroom talking. He asked her for \$10 for fuel for his vehicle. She refused to pay Dennis for visiting their son, which angered him. According to Tristin, Dennis threw her to the floor, and when she stood up he forcefully pushed her backwards causing the back of her head to strike and break a television. Robert entered the bedroom after hearing the scuffle and Tristin scream. Dennis immediately exited the house to flee. Tristin met Dennis prior to him entering his vehicle, which resulted in Dennis punching her in the face and throwing her to the ground. Tristin reported curling up to protect herself as Dennis continued to punch and kick her. Tristin reported feeling light headed and complained of body pain. Lacey EMS responded to the scene to assess Tristin. Inside the ambulance, I observed that Tristin had dry blood around her lip, redness and swelling on the right side of her face and an EMT reported feeling swollen areas on the back of her head. Tristin reported (did not witness the assault. I read Tristin the rear page of the VINE form and explained her rights as a victim of domestic violence. Tristin reported she understood her rights and would pursue a TRQ application after she is released from Community Medical Center. She was transported for medical attention.

Robert reported he and (heard Tristin screaming. He went to check on Tristin and observed Tristin crying as Dennis left the room. He followed Tristin outside to the driveway and observed Dennis punch her several times before throwing her to the ground.

At police headquarters, I attempted to call Dennis twice. Both attempts yielded negative contacts. I then charged Dennis with simple assault (2C:12-1A (1)) on warrant 1512 W 2021 000028. A copy of the warrant was faxed to Roselle Park Police Department because Dennis' last known address is in their jurisdiction.

A NJ domestic violence supplemental report was completed and submitted. The Division of Child Protection and Permanency (DCP&P) was advised of the incident. A DCP&P caseworker will be responding within 24 hours.

Dennis was not in custody at the time of this report. He was entered as wanted in the NCIC system.
