NARRATIVE**1. OPERATION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE:**

On May 08, 2020 at 1448 hours, I was dispatched in marked Unit #38 to the area of Costco Drive regarding a male subject that possibly overdosed in a tractor trailer. Dispatch advised that the caller stated that he suspected the subject used heroin and that he was not entering the tractor trailer. Dispatch further advised that the caller was also the subject's supervisor.

2. ARRIVAL AT SCENE:

Upon arrival, I approached a white Volvo tractor trailer (New Jersey Temporary Registration - V219993) from the Westbound lanes on Costco Drive. The tractor trailer was parked on the Eastbound side of Costco Drive, and the Monroe Twp. First Aid was on scene. The Monroe Twp. First Aid was entering the tractor trailer's cab to make contact with the driver as I passed the tractor trailer to perform a U-Turn to park behind it. When passing the tractor trailer, I further observed a male subject sitting in the driver's seat of the tractor trailer with his forehead resting on the steering wheel through the driver's side window. At this time, I positioned Unit #38 behind the aforementioned tractor trailer and exited my patrol vehicle. I subsequently approached the driver's side of the tractor trailer, and observed a male subject, identified as [REDACTED], in the driver seat. It is to be noted that the tractor trailer's engine was on. The Monroe Twp. First Aid was assessing [REDACTED] who was now conscious and no longer resting his head on the steering wheel. I then asked the Monroe Twp. First Aid if Naloxone was administered on [REDACTED], to which they advised that it was not utilized. The Monroe Twp. First Aid further stated that they did not observe any narcotics or paraphernalia while making initial contact with [REDACTED]. I also observed a raised bump on [REDACTED] forehead.

At this time, I asked [REDACTED] if he had overdosed, to which he stated that he did not and was tired from a long drive. [REDACTED] appeared to be disoriented and stated that he received his shipment in North Carolina and it was intended to be dropped off at Costco in Monroe Township. It is to be noted that [REDACTED] speech was slow and slurred. [REDACTED] was unable to explain how or when he arrived at this location and continued to explain that he was tired. While speaking with [REDACTED], I observed

his eyes to be bloodshot and watery. [REDACTED] pupils were also pinpoint and I could see perspiration on his face and neck. I then requested [REDACTED] drivers license and he slowly fumbled through his wallet to provide me with his identification. I advised for [REDACTED] to exit the tractor trailer, to which he complied. The Monroe Twp. First Aid continued to evaluate [REDACTED] further advised the Monroe Twp. First Aid that both of his ankles were swollen and stated that he did not know why they were.

At this time, I began speaking with the caller, Carltony Johnson, as well as the registered owner and owner of the trucking company, Daniel Charles 2nd, on scene. Mr. Charles advised that [REDACTED] was not going to continue driving the tractor trailer, and wanted possession of his truck back to complete the delivery. I advised Mr. Charles that he was allowed to do so as he was the owner of the company and registered owner of the vehicle. Mr. Charles subsequently advised that Mr. Johnson was going to drive the tractor trailer. At this time, [REDACTED] refused further medical attention from the Monroe Twp. First Aid. Mr. Charles then requested for [REDACTED] to remove his belongings from the vehicle, to which he complied. I then accompanied [REDACTED] to the tractor trailer's cab, where he gathered his cell phone, wallet, cigarettes, and clip board. [REDACTED] then allowed Mr. Charles access to the tractor trailer to complete the delivery.

Mr. Johnson subsequently opened the passenger door and advised that he observed suspected narcotics in a small glassine bag on the passenger side floor. Mr. Johnson retrieved the small glassine bag and I advised him to place it down and exit the vehicle. I further observed the small glassine bag, which contained a white powdery substance on the passenger side floor. I then secured the tractor trailer.

Sgt. Leung arrived on scene.

At this time, I asked [REDACTED] if he used the white powdery substance contained in the glassine bag. [REDACTED] advised that he did not and that it may have been left in there by someone he allowed in the tractor trailer's cab. [REDACTED] was unable to identify any individuals that were in the tractor trailer's cab.

I then confirmed that field sobriety tests could be captured on Unit #38's L3 Camera. All of Unit #38's front facing emergency lighting was deactivated as to not affect the field sobriety tests. I observed a knife clipped to [REDACTED]

██████████ right pocket and advised him that I would be removing it from his person for officer safety. ██████████ complied and I asked him to remove any other items from his pockets, to which he also complied. His belongings were then placed on the curb next to the vehicle. I then had ██████████ walk to the front of Unit #38 where the roadway was flat, and clear of any debris. I then told ██████████ to stand with his feet together and his arms down at his sides while I administered the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test. I confirmed that ██████████ could see the tip of my pen and I explained for him to not move his head and only move his eyes with the stimulus while I administered the test. ██████████ stated that he understood. ██████████ then got into position and I noticed him swaying for balance while he stood. I then administered the test. I checked both eyes for equal tracking and they both tracked equally. Both eyes also lacked smooth pursuit. While conducting the test, I detected a distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation and Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. As I was administering the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test, I observed ██████████ eyes to be bloodshot and watery and his pupils to be pinpoint.

I then began to demonstrate and instruct the Walk and Turn test to ██████████. I told ██████████ to put his right foot in front of his left foot. ██████████ explained that he had pressure in his ankles, which hurt to stand in that position. ██████████ was unable to balance in that position due to the pain in his ankles. The Walk and Turn test was subsequently terminated. I then demonstrated and instructed the One Leg Stand test to ██████████. ██████████ advised that he could not perform the test due to the pain in his swollen ankles. The One Leg Stand test was subsequently terminated and ██████████ was placed under arrest. ██████████ was handcuffed (double locked and checked for proper fit) and searched incident to arrest. ██████████ was then placed into the prisoner compartment of Unit #38 without incident.

At this time, I searched the interior of the tractor trailer for suspected contraband. I subsequently retrieved the aforementioned glassine bag containing a white powdery substance from the passenger side floor. I then retrieved a capped hypodermic syringe in a Walgreens Insulin Syringe pack, which was located above the driver's seat in a storage area. The syringe appeared to contain suspected heroin residue. I also retrieved a cap suspected to be from a hypodermic syringe, which was located in the center console area. A search of ██████████ belongings, which were located on the curb, yielded six (6) unstamped wax folds containing suspected heroin located in a Marlboro Cigarette pack.

All contraband was subsequently secured in an evidence bag and placed in the trunk of Unit #38. At this time, [REDACTED] advised me that he was feeling sick and that he needed to vomit. I then opened the prisoner compartment of Unit #38 and [REDACTED] began vomiting. I asked [REDACTED] if he needed medical attention, to which he shook his head that he did. I then requested for the Monroe Twp. First Aid to be dispatched to the scene. While standing by with [REDACTED], he began to cry and repeatedly uttered that he was sorry and that he did not remember what had happened. [REDACTED] further uttered that he was having a difficult time due to his father passing away. A short time later, the Monroe Twp. First Aid arrived on scene and [REDACTED] was escorted from Unit #38 to the ambulance without incident.

I then reviewed the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office Consent Form for Use by Law Enforcement Officers when Requesting consent to test and draw blood document with [REDACTED] subsequently signed the document indicating that he is knowingly and voluntarily giving consent to take and test his blood samples.

3. EN ROUTE TO HOSPITAL:

While en route to Princeton Medical Center, I remained in the ambulance with [REDACTED]. While [REDACTED] was laying on the stretcher he uttered, "I fucked up." [REDACTED] also continued to cry.

4. AT HOSPITAL:

Upon arrival at Princeton Medical Center, Ofc. Wilson was awaiting. RN Ernesto Gibson #73368974 then obtained the blood samples from [REDACTED] and the blood samples were secured in Blood Kit #1886165 (Exp. 06/30/2020). Princeton Medical Center (RN Ernesto Gibson #73368974) refused to sign the Potential Liability Warning for [REDACTED]. I then advised [REDACTED] to contact the Monroe Twp. Municipal Court regarding his court appearance due to the COVID-19 Epidemic.

5. AT HEADQUARTERS:

Upon arrival at Headquarters, Blood Kit #1886165 was properly secured in the evidence refrigerator. All other seized evidence was properly secured. Property reports were completed to preserve Unit #38's L3 Recording and initial 9-1-1 phone call.
