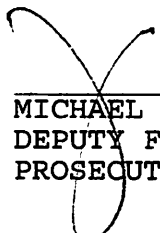

THIRD DEGREE CRIME

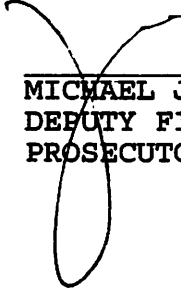
