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On 8/1/2024 at 1559hrs, in marked patrol unit 709, my partner P/O E Ramos 568 and I were dispatched to a disturbance in the post office located at 680 Rt 130 Hamilton. Prior to our arrival, dispatch stated there was a party in the lobby videotaping the area and staff. They were advised by the caller that she was not causing a disturbance but would not leave when asked.

Upon our arrival, we made contact with the party that was videotaping who identified herself as Jen. Jen stated she was reviewing the literature that is posted by the post office and notified the supervisor that the documents were outdated. Jen stated that the supervisor stated she did not wish to be videotaped and contacted the police. When requested Jen stated she would prefer not to provide her information.

After speaking to Jen, we were asked to enter an office in the entrance of the post office. At that time we spoke with supervisor Shaday Love, who stated she did not want to be videotaped and did not know why the woman was there. I advised Shaday that this is common and that parties frequently audit federal and local government agencies. Shaday was further advised of the parties constitutional rights and that there is no expectation of privacy in public or publicly assessable areas. Shaday was encouraged to educate herself and staff on situation like this due to them becoming more common.

After speaking with Shaday, I spoke with Jen again and told her that Shaday was advised of the situation. Jen stated she only wanted to educate the postal workers on the proper documentation and at no time was causing a disturbance. Jen was advised how to obtain the police report and body worn camera footage. She was then provided a case number along with my partner and my badge numbers.

Both parties were provided case number and advised.

This report is a brief synopsis of the event that occurred. Refer to my body worn camera footage for the full detailed report of this incident.
