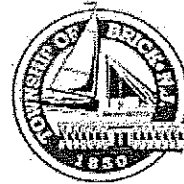

On 5/18/10 at 0616 hours Ptl. Pacitti # 238 and I were dispatched to 1612 Fort St. in reference to domestic violence.

Upon arrival I spoke with the victim Catharine Patterson who stated that her ex-father in law Lawrence Westphal assaulted her boyfriend and then left the residence.

Patterson stated that she saw someone at her bedroom window and then heard banging on her sliding glass door. She got out of bed to see who was at the door and her boyfriend Robert Amogretti stayed in the bedroom.

Patterson saw her ex-father in law banging on the door and opened it a little to tell him the leave. As soon as Patterson open the door Westphal pushed the door and Patterson out of the way so he could enter the residence. Westphal ran down the hallway and opened the bedroom door where Amogretti was standing. Westphal attacked Amogretti and the two began to wrestle around the bedroom. During the struggle the dry wall in the bedroom was damaged. Patterson shouted at Westphal to stop or she was calling the police. Upon hearing this Westphal fled the residence in his vehicle.

It should be noted that Amogretti also left the residence prior to our arrival because he had to go to work. I then spoke to Amogretti on the phone and he stated he did not want to sign complaints against Westphal. Amogretti also stated that he is in between residences now and does not have a address.

Patterson was explained follow-up and complaint procedures.

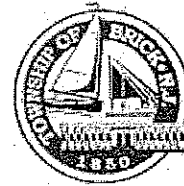
On 3-21-2010 at approximately 1700 hours Catharine Patterson responded to Brick Police Department Headquarters to make a report of harassment.

Upon her arrival I spoke with Patterson. Patterson stated she has been getting harassed by a John Sprosty. Patterson stated Sprosty is her husband's, Quincy Patterson, friend. Patterson stated a few weeks ago Sprosty claimed to have his residence burglarized. Patterson stated on March 15, 2010 Sprosty contacted her and stated that he believes Quincy burglarized his residence. According to Patterson Sprosty wants her to pay him back for all the damage that was done to his home and for the items that were stolen out of his residence during the burglary. Patterson stated Sprosty is a drug addict and so is her husband. Patterson stated she believes Sprosty just wants her to give him money so he can buy drugs. Patterson stated Sprosty has told her if she gives him money he won't tell the police her husband is a suspect. Patterson stated since March 15, 2010 Sprosty has showed up at her residence twice and has been calling leaving her messages. Patterson stated she has asked him to stop calling, but he continues to.

I advised Patterson of proper complaint procedures. I was unable to speak with Sprosty at the time of this report.

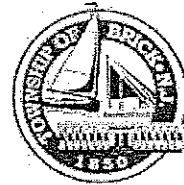

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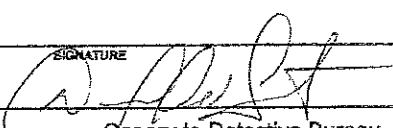
