Based on information obtained from the murder investigation this phone belonged to Angelo A. Greci. A forensic examination of the seized cell phone yielded over 1000 images of children either engaged in a prohibited sexual act or the simulation of such act or portraying children in a sexually suggestive manner, making them images of child pornography.

- A. On Saturday, November 14, 2020, at approximately 1909 hours, Toms River Police responded to Community Medical Center in reference to a male that was admitted to their facility with an apparent stab wound to the neck. The victim was identified as Carlton Williams (DOB: [REDACTED]). Williams was subsequently flown to Robert Wood Johnson Medical Center to be treated for his injuries.
- B. Upon arrival at the hospital, Toms River Police spoke with Brittney Speer (DOB: [REDACTED]). In short, Speer related that she and her boyfriend, Williams, were involved in an incident in the Manitou Park section of Berkeley Township. At approximately 1934 hours, Toms River Police contacted the Berkeley Township Police Department to advise them of the incident.
- C. Berkeley Township Police responded to Community Medical Center and transported Speer to Berkeley Township Police Headquarters to conduct a statement. The audio/video recorded statement, which took place at the Berkeley Township Police Department, was conducted by Detective Anthony Carrington III, of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office, and the undersigned. In short, Speer related the following.
- D. Williams asked Speer to take him to the area of Magnolia Gardens to meet an individual she knows as "120". Wali Hobbs is known by law enforcement to use the aliases "120" and "Farad Greene". Approximately one week prior, Speer drove Williams to the area of Magnolia Gardens in order for Williams to lend "120" \$200.00.
- E. On November 14, 2020, Williams was contacted by "120" to meet at Magnolia Gardens to repay the \$200. Speer and Williams went to Magnolia Gardens and parked in the rear of the complex. A grey Nissan Altima parked behind her vehicle. Speer stated that she knows "120" to operate a grey Nissan Altima. Upon arrival of said vehicle, Williams exits the front passenger seat of the vehicle and stands next to the open door. Speer subsequently observed a black male, whom she knows as "120", exit the driver-side of the Nissan Altima and walked to the passenger-side of the vehicle and give Williams what she believed to be a quantity of money. Williams then

places the quantity of money in his right pocket. Speer further added that Williams was wearing a pair of sweatpants under his jeans which is where he typically keeps money. This was consistent with where a quantity of money was recovered from Williams's sweatpants at Community Medical Center.

- F.** Following the exchange, "120" walked back toward the driver-side of his vehicle. Prior to entering the vehicle, "120" yelled to Williams and asked for a cigarette. Williams reached inside of the car, at which time an unknown individual jumped on Williams back and assaulted him. Speer described said individual as a bigger male, taller than Williams.
- G.** As Williams was attempting to get back in the car, Speer exited the vehicle and observed a grey Nissan Altima. Speer observed an individual get in the front passenger-side seat and the individual that committed the assault get in the rear passenger-side seat. Speer stated that due to the interior lights of the vehicle being illuminated she was able to observe the front passenger partially remove a ski mask. Speer described the front passenger as a white male having a blonde/light colored beard. Speer stated that the rear passenger was wearing a black ski mask that had a single opening for both eyes which gave her the ability to identify him as a black male. Following the incident, Speer drove the Williams to the hospital in her vehicle.
- H.** At the conclusion of the interview, Speer consented to the search of her 1999 Ford Explorer bearing New Jersey registration [REDACTED] Said vehicle is the vehicle that Speer drove the victim to Community Medical Center. Speer also waived her right to be present during said search. Speer also consented to the search of her cell phone and to provide buccal swabs and major case prints.
- I.** On Saturday, November 14, 2020, at approximately 2320 hours, a search of the aforementioned vehicle was conducted at the Ocean County Sheriff's Office, Crime Scene Investigations Unit. A search of the vehicle yielded multiple items of evidentiary value,

specifically a bundle of wax folds stamped with "LIKE" and an image of thumbs up in blue, as well as numerous swabs of red staining from the interior and exterior of the vehicle.

- J.** On Saturday, November 14, 2020, Detective Carrington applied to the Court telephonically for a Search Warrant for the cell phone recovered from Williams's property at Community Medical Center. The Search Warrant, which was approved by Senior Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman, was authorized by the Honorable Stephen Nemeth on November 15, 2020, at 0005 hours. The cell phone was subsequently turned over to Detective Depalma of the High Tech Crime Squad for extraction.
- K.** Detective Denis Mitchell, of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office, was provided a copy of the extraction by Detective Depalma. A review of said extraction was conducted by Detective Mitchell and yielded the following.
- L.** A conversation between the victim and an individual under the contact name "One Twenty 120" utilizing telephone facility [REDACTED] commenced on November 14, 2020, at approximately 1514 hours. The conversation is in reference to the two meeting up. The conversation ends at 1830 hours. At 1925 hours, "One Twenty 120" says "Wtf happen ion even know". Said message was unread. A review of the call log yielded approximately five (5) calls between the victim and "One Twenty 120" from 1830 hours to 1847 hours. The victim has a missed call from the same contact at approximately 1924 hours.
- M.** A review of the contacts in William's phone yielded an additional contact in his phone with the contact name "120". The associated telephone facility with said contact is [REDACTED]
- N.** Detective Reilly, of the Manchester Township Police Department, stated that he is familiar with Amanda Howland, through an active investigation. Howland is known to Detective Reilly to operate a dark in colored Nissan as of April 2020. Howland is known by law

enforcement to be in a dating relationship with Wali Hobbs. Furthermore, Hobbs and Howland are known by law enforcement to have a child in common.

- O. A DMV look up of Howland yielded a brown in color 2006 Ford Fusion bearing New Jersey registration [REDACTED]. The look up also yielded an address of [REDACTED]
- P. On Sunday, November 15, 2020, Detective Sergeant John Carroll, of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office, requested that Sergeant Jim Hill, of the High Tech Crime Squad, run New Jersey registration number [REDACTED] through the ALPR System. Sergeant Hill advised that the aforementioned vehicle registered on an ALPR located on Route 166 in Toms River on November 14, 2020, at approximately 1739 hours. Additionally, the vehicle registered with an ALPR in Seaside Heights on November 15, 2020, at 0156 hours.
- Q. On Sunday, November 15, 2020, detectives responded to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and located the abovementioned car parked in the driveway of the townhome. The residence can be described as a three story, gray in color townhouse style dwelling, with stone covered siding on the first floor, surrounding a white in color garage door. The garage is the furthest to the right in a multi-unit driveway. Immediately to the right of the driveway is a walkway from the sidewalk to a breezeway of the building. Affixed to the awning of the breezeway is a white in color sign with "BLDG. #8 UNITS 801-815" written in black, through the breezeway, the furthest northeast door, is white in color, with "811" affixed horizontally on the door.
- R. On Sunday, November 15, 2020, at approximately 1530 hours, Detective Brant Uricks, of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office, and Detective Bowens, of the Berkeley Township Police Department, were conducting surveillance of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in an attempt to locate Wali Hobbs and Amanda Howland. At approximately 1546 hours, Detectives Uricks and Bowens observed a male and female walking from the parking lot inside the breezeway of unit 811. Detective Uricks

advised that the heavier black male in the deep reddish hoodie appeared to have a general description consistent with Wali Hobbs. Detective Kristie Buble from the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Narcotics Strike Force was positioned in the rear of the unit and observed the same individual at that time walk inside unit 811.

- S.** On Sunday, November 15, 2020, Detective Brant Uricks spoke with the Ocean County Sheriff's Office in reference to Wali Hobbs. Detective Uricks was advised that Hobbs is currently on parole and his handling officer is Parole Officer Carlos Perez-Moreno. PO Perez-Moreno provided Detective Uricks with the address of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] as being Hobbs's current address. PO Perez-Moreno further provided telephone numbers [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]-[REDACTED] as being telephone facilities utilized by Hobbs.
- T.** On November 15, 2020, Brittany Speer responded to the Berkeley Police Department to provide a taped statement. The statement, which was conducted by Detective Carrington and the undersigned, was audio/video recorded. Speer was read her Miranda rights to which she acknowledged that she understood. Furthermore, Speer signed the waiver portion of the Miranda form indicating that she was willing to speak with detectives without an attorney present.
- U.** This statement deviated from Speer's statement on November 14, 2020, on two points. These two points are as follows; in summation, Speer stated immediately following the altercation she looked in her rear-view mirror. At which time, Speer observed "120" in the driver-seat of the vehicle. Speer observed an individual in the passenger-front side. Speer stated that the individual pulled the face mask half way up, at which time, Speer described the individual as a white male with a light colored facial hair. Speer described a male whom she believed committed the assault in the passenger-rear. Speer described the individual as a black male with a full faced mask with a bar opening for the eyes. The second point; Speer stated that when exiting the Magnolia Gardens parking lot to bring Williams to the hospital, the actor vehicle was in front of her, which she described

as a grey colored sedan type vehicle. Speer was unable to observe a registration for the vehicle.

- V. On Sunday, November 15, 2020, Detective Mitchell applied to the Court for a Search Warrant for the 2006 Ford Fusion bearing New Jersey registration [REDACTED]. The Search Warrant, which was approved by Senior Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman, was authorized by the Honorable Steven Nemeth at 2149 hours. Said vehicle was towed to the Ocean County Sheriff's Office, Crime Scene Investigations Unit, where it was secured pending execution of said Search Warrant.
- W. On Sunday, November 15, 2020, Detective Mitchell applied to the Court for a Search Warrant for [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. The Search Warrant, which was approved by Senior Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman, was authorized by the Honorable Steven Nemeth at 2152 hours.
- X. On Sunday, November 15, 2020, at approximately 2231 hours, the abovementioned Search Warrant was executed by members of the Toms River Police Department, Ocean County Prosecutor's Office, Ocean County Sheriff's Office, and Berkeley Township Police Department.
- Y. Present at the residence at the time of execution were Wali Hobbs and Amanda Howland. Hobbs was subsequently transported to the Berkeley Township Police Department.
- Z. A search of the residence yielded the collection of numerous electronic devices, specifically a black in color Apple iPhone with a gold in color semi-transparent case covering the back and sides and bronze in color glitter contained within the back of the case. The search also resulted in the collection of a black ski mask, a red sweatshirt, a black in flannel shirt, a gray Polo hat, a pair of Timberland boots with staining, and a Lincoln car key. All items were photographed by members of the Ocean County Sheriff's Office, Crime Scene Investigations Unit. The cell phones were subsequently turned over to Detective Mitchell. All other items were secured by the Ocean County Sheriff's Office, Crime Scene Investigations Unit.

AA. Also discovered during the execution of said Search Warrant were various legal documents for Omar Alfred.

BB. During the execution of the Search Warrant at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED], at approximately 2315 hours, Amanda Howland was speaking with investigators and made the utterance in the presence of Detective Brant Uricks and Lieutenant Brian Haggerty that we should be speaking with Omar Alfred and that Kevin Stokes also knows what happened. She advised that the stabbing was the result of "some jail shit". Howland advised that last she knew Omar Alfred resided in [REDACTED].

CC. On November 15, 2020, Detective Carrington and the undersigned conducted an interview with Wali Hobbs at the Berkeley Township Police Department. Hobbs was transported from his residence at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] following the execution of a Court authorized search warrant. Hobbs was read his Miranda Rights which he acknowledged that he understood and signed the OCPO Miranda Rights Waiver Form confirming that he was willing to speak us. In summation, Hobbs stated the following during the interview.

DD. Hobbs stated that on November 14, 2020, his cousin, Omar Alfred, and he were in the parking lot of Magnolia Gardens Apartment Complex, located at 235 Magnolia Ave, in the Manitou Section of Berkeley Township to meet up with a male known to Hobbs as 'Born', AKA Carlton Williams. Hobbs and Alfred were being driven by another male known to Hobbs as 'A' in a gray sedan. Hobbs met with Born in the rear parking lot of the Magnolia Gardens Apartment Complex. Born was in a green truck with his girlfriend that was parked in a parking spot. 'A' parked his car behind the vehicle Born was in.

EE. Hobbs was meeting Born to receive money that he loaned Born. After parking, Born walked up to the vehicle that Hobbs was in and handed him the money. Hobbs asked Born for a cigarette and he returned to his truck to retrieve the cigarette. When Born was walking back to the gray sedan, he was fixated on the driver, 'A'. Hobbs takes the cigarette and looks down to count the money he had

received. While counting he heard the driver's door open and when he looked up he observed 'A' and Born fighting. Hobbs and Alfred exited the vehicle and broke up the fight.

FF. Hobbs observed a small amount of blood on Born, but did not realize that he had been stabbed. He believed that the wound was superficial. Hobbs told the girlfriend to take Born to the hospital.

GG. Next, Hobbs, Alfred and 'A' exited the area in the gray sedan heading east on Magnolia Ave. Hobbs stated that they eventually stopped at Sawyers' Liquors in Beachwood where they exited the vehicle and began walking to another location to meet with Hobbs' girlfriend.

HH. Upon conclusion of the interview, the undersigned entered the interview room and turned the camera off. Immediately upon turning the camera off Hobbs uttered "Angelo".

II. Detectives conducted a New Jersey Department of Corrections inmate look-up for male inmates, current and released, with the first name Angelo. Said search yielded twenty-eight (28) results. Among the results was an individual named Angelo Greci.

JJ. Detectives involved in this investigation are familiar with Angelo Greci and are aware that Greci goes by the nickname "A". Detectives involved in this investigation are also aware of an incident that occurred in 2016 in the Ocean County Jail in which Greci was assaulted and stabbed multiple times.

KK. On November 16, 2020, Detective Sergeant Carroll reached out to Sergeant Mike Delanoy, of the Ocean County Corrections Department. Sergeant Delanoy advised that on February 16, 2016, Greci was involved in an incident in which he was stabbed while housed at the Ocean County Jail. Sergeant Delanoy provided the reports in relation to the same. A review of the reports yielded that on the aforementioned date, six (6) individuals entered the cell of Greci at the time of the alleged assault. Among the six (6) individuals involved in the alleged assault was Brandon Meechum. Sergeant

Delanoy also provided the daily housing report for South A, where the incident occurred. A Review of the report yielded Meechum as the bunkmate of Carlton Williams at the time of the assault. Grenchi refused to cooperate with the investigation, resulting in no charges being filed.

LL. Detective Mike Ricciardelli, of the Berkeley Township Police Department, conducted a DMV look up of Grenchi, as well as his immediate family members. The DMV look up of Grenchi yielded a home address of [REDACTED]

MM. Detective Ricciardelli also conducted a DMV look up of Grenchi's mother, Geraldine Grenchi. Said look up also yielded a home address of [REDACTED]. The look up also yielded Geraldine Grenchi as the registered owner of a silver in color 2013 Chrysler 300 bearing New Jersey registration number [REDACTED]

NN. Following the aforementioned, Detective Sergeant Carroll contacted Sergeant Jim Hill, of the High Tech Crime Squad, and requested the abovementioned New Jersey registration number be ran through the ALPR system for November 14, 2020. Sergeant Hill related that on November 14, 2020, the vehicle registered with an ALPR located in Seaside Heights. At approximately 1938 hours, on the same date, the vehicle registered with an ALPR on Route 166 in Toms River. At approximately 2249 hours, the vehicle registered with an ALPR in Seaside Heights.

OO. On November 16, 2020, Detective Uricks contacted PO Perez-Moreno in reference to Grenchi. PO Perez-Moreno related that Grenchi is currently on parole and assigned to his supervision. PO Perez-Moreno related the following. Grenchi operates a silver in color Chrysler 300. Grenchi's home address is [REDACTED]. PO Perez-Moreno last spoke with Grenchi on the morning of November 16, 2020. PO Perez-Moreno knows Grenchi to utilize telephone facility [REDACTED] and has spoken with him numerous times using said facility. PO Perez-Moreno advised that in

his last conversation with Grenci, Grenci related that he was on his way to Wildwood.

PP. On Monday, November 16, 2020, detectives responded to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in an attempt to make contact with Omar Alfred. Detectives were able to make contact with Alfred. Alfred advised that he was willing to respond to the Berkeley Township Police Department to speak with detectives. While at the Berkeley Township Police Department, Detective Carrington and the undersigned conducted the taped statement of Alfred. In short, Alfred related the following.

QQ. Alfred was in Seaside Heights on November 14, 2020. He made contact with Angelo, the driver of the gray sedan, for a ride between 2pm and 3pm. Next, they went to the Beachcomber Bar and reportedly drank there for one to two hours. Next, they departed Seaside Heights en route to meet up with Wali Hobbs at the Magnolia Gardens apartments in the Manitou Park Section of Berkeley Township. Angelo and Alfred arrived at Magnolia Gardens and picked up Hobbs. They then drove to Sawyers Liquor Store located in Beachwood. Upon their arrival, Hobbs entered the store and purchased a bottle of Crown Royal and some beers. Next they returned to the Magnolia Gardens apartments where they pulled up to the rear of the complex to meet with Born. This meeting was setup by Hobbs and Alfred stated that he did not know why he was meeting with him.

RR. Angelo parked the gray sedan behind the vehicle that Born was traveling in. Alfred then stated that Born walked to the car where he had a short conversation with Hobbs and shook hands with him. Born then walks back to his car, when the driver's side door opened and Angelo attacked Born. Hobbs and Alfred exited the vehicle and pulled Angelo off of Born. Alfred recalls seeing the blood and they got back in the car and left the area. After leaving the area they went back to Sawyer's Liquors Store. Hobbs went back into the liquor store. While Alfred and Angelo were in the car they began arguing about what had just occurred. Subsequently, Angelo made multiple

statements to Alfred indicating that Williams and Angelo had an issue in jail where something happened to Angelo. Alfred identified a photograph of Angelo Grenci as the individual he was referring to as "Angelo."

SS. Alfred subsequently consented to the search of his cell phone. The cell phone was turned over to the High Tech Crime Squad for extraction.

Said Search Warrant, which was approved by Senior Assistant Prosecutor Michael Abatemarco, was authorized by the Honorable Steven Nemeth at 1751 hours. Said vehicle was subsequently secured and towed to the Ocean County Sheriff's Office, Crime Scene Investigations Unit, pending execution of the same.

VV. On Monday, November 16, 2020, Detective Mitchell applied to the Court for a Search Warrant for [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Said Search Warrant, which was approved by Senior Assistant Prosecutor Michael Abatemarco, was authorized by the Honorable Steven Nemeth at 1753 hours. YY. Angelo Greci was present at the residence at the time of execution of the abovementioned Search Warrant. Upon encountering Greci, officer's recovered a knife from his waistband. Greci was subsequently transported to the Berkeley Township Police Department. While at the Berkeley Township Police Department, Detective Sergeant John Carroll and the undersigned conducted the taped statement of Greci. Greci stated that he was not willing to speak with detectives.

ZZ. On Monday, November 16, 2020, at approximately 2245 hours, the aforementioned Search Warrant was executed on the 2003 silver in color Chrysler 300 bearing New Jersey registration number [REDACTED]. Present for the search were members of the Ocean County Prosecutor's

AAA. A search of the vehicle yielded various amounts of red staining within the vehicle. Red staining from the interior of the vehicle, specifically the driver's side door panel, was tested utilizing a BLUESTAR OPTI screening test. The test yielded a presumptive positive for human blood.

BBB. On Tuesday, November 17, 2020, the abovementioned facts were presented to Senior Assistant Prosecutor Michael Abatemarco. Senior Assistant Prosecutor Abatemarco approved the charge of Attempted Murder in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1 - 2C:11-3A(1) against Angelo Grenci.
