Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On 07/03/2017 at approximately 1903 hours I, Ptl. Tyler Ragauckas #367, was on patrol when I came across a motor vehicle accident on Ocean Avenue and Pearl Street, Lakewood, NJ. As I exited my vehicle, I was approached by a witness who stated a black male in a white T-Shirt and dark colored shorts exited an Acura, bearing NJ [REDACTED], that was involved in the accident. The black male reached into the trunk area where he was seen removing CDS and then running north on Pearl Street towards Woehr Ave. At this time, I radioed out the information to surrounding units while I began to speak with the driver of the Acura, Idequan Allen. I asked Idequan Allen who ran from the vehicle and he stated it was his friend, Jahvonte, but would not provide a last name. While continuing to speak with Allen, I asked him to retrieve his credentials from the vehicle to which he complied. When he entered the vehicle, I detected a strong odor of raw marijuana from inside the vehicle. I am familiar with the odor of marijuana in both raw and burnt forms based on my training and experience. A search of the vehicle was conducted where a large clear plastic baggie containing a green vegetation indicative of marijuana was recovered from the trunk where the spare tire is secured. Allen was then placed under arrest. Ptl. Kevin Donnelly #353 then located a black male matching the description of the individual who ran from the Acura, identified as Jahvonte Debose. Ptl. Kevin Donnelly #353 detected a strong odor of raw marijuana emanating from Debose's person where a search was then conducted. Ptl. Kevin Donnelly #353 recovered five large clear plastic baggies containing a green vegetation indicative of marijuana. Debose was then placed under arrest.
