- A. On Sunday, February 21, 2021 at 1940 hours, two 911 calls were placed to Ocean County Communications Center in reference to a report of shots fired at [REDACTED] in Lakewood, New Jersey, as well as a male who had collapsed in the middle of the road at [REDACTED] Lakewood Police Department responded to the scene and located a male in the middle of the roadway. Lakewood Patrol Officer Connor Woods provided first aid to the victim for an apparent gunshot wound to the chest, and asked the victim what his name was to which he responded "Dajour Randolph." Officer Woods then asked the victim who shot him to which he responded "Jahvontae." The male was transported to Kimball Medical Center in Lakewood, New Jersey, where he was subsequently pronounced dead at 2045 hours by Dr. Larsen.
- B. Upon further investigation, a dash cam recording was located in a vehicle across the street from [REDACTED]. The video was reviewed by officers and was found to have captured footage of an individual walking up from the sidewalk in front of unit [REDACTED] to unit [REDACTED] in a hurried fashion. At that point it appears a male comes from inside the residence and it appears multiple gunshots are fired. It appears there may be two individuals who exit the residence. The decedent then runs from the residence and is seen again walking in front of the vehicle with the dash cam recording utilizing his cellular phone.
- C. During a canvass of the area, police located a 2019 Black Nissan Rogue bearing New Jersey registration [REDACTED] idling within the vicinity of [REDACTED]. The motor vehicle came back to a registered owner of William Hero (DOB: [REDACTED]). Detective Brant Uricks of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office along with This Affiant of the Lakewood Police Department took a statement from the decedent's mother, Latoya Randolph. During this interview, she explained

that William Hero is an elderly man she helps to take care of and that the decedent has been using his vehicle for the past month.

- D. A black iPhone 11 in a turquoise case with the word "Merkury" on it was located on the trunk of a 2020 Hyundai Sonata, parked in front of [REDACTED]. Blood appeared to be present on the phone.
- E. During an inspection of the exterior of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] officers observed what appeared to be a camera located on the outside of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] over the front door. Law enforcement attempted to speak to Delfinda Lawson, a resident of [REDACTED] in order to obtain access to the camera. Lawson stated that the camera did not work. Law enforcement observed a light on the camera and heard shuttering and clicking noises as though the camera was detecting motion. When the homeowner was asked who was present at the residence, she stated that it was just her and another elderly woman. At that time, patrol officers from Lakewood Police Department were behind the residence and observed multiple people in the upstairs portion of the home.
- F. Lakewood Police conducted a lookup of residents associated with the address of [REDACTED]. Police found a Jahvontae Debose (DOB: 11/05/96) resided at [REDACTED] through his motor vehicle registration. Additionally, a Derrick Lawson (DOB: [REDACTED]) was found to reside at [REDACTED], and is currently in possession of an active NJ Firearms ID Card as of 12/18/2019.
- G. On February 21, 2021, at 1114 hours, Detective Nicole Testa of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office contacted the Honorable Wendel E. Daniels, P.J. Cr. P. to obtain a search warrant for [REDACTED], a 2019 Black Nissan Rogue bearing NJ registration [REDACTED] and the black iPhone 11 in the turquoise case with the word Merkury on it. Judge Daniels subsequently authorized the physical search of [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

J. On Monday, February 22, 2021, Detective Brant Uricks and this Affiant took formal statements of Derrick Lawson and Delfinda Lawson, the uncle and mother of Jahvontae Debose and residents of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Both parties provided inconsistent stories as to the descriptions of the events of the night. Specifically, they provided contradictory information about which of them heard fireworks and which heard gunshots.

Specifically, he stated he had permits for 3 pistols and 1 long gun, however a review of his actual permits by Lakewood Police Department showed he had permits for 4 handguns. It should be noted during a search of the residence only 3 handguns were found.

- K. On Monday, February 22, 2021, Detective Raymond Coles of the Ocean County Prosecutor's High Tech Crime Unit received the telephone extraction of the black iPhone 11 in the Turquoise phone case with the word "Merkury" on it, recovered from the scene. The phone number assigned to the iPhone 11 was determined by Detective Coles during his forensic examination to be [REDACTED], the same number identified as being the victim's phone by his mother and brother. Upon reviewing the text message conversations, a conversation was observed between [REDACTED] (hereinafter the decedent's phone) and phone number [REDACTED], that occurred on February 21, 2021. At 1800 hours, the contact number of [REDACTED] sent an unknown photo attachment to the decedent. The decedent responded at 1801 hours stating "ok got you". At 1801 the contact number asked the decedent "What's good doe" and the decedent then asked "how much for the zips of 50\$". The contact responded "360". The decedent responded at 1804 hours "Damn g". At 1804 hours, the contact replied "350 the lowest" and the decedent replied "So the quaps is taxe". At 1805, the decedent told the contact "I want all 3 flavors of the 50\$ balls, but I'll loose out on on profit if I cop at 360". At 1805, the contact said, "Depending if you get white Tahoe 750 and the sour 8 if you mix em both". The decedent responded asking "is that regular of designer". The contact replied "All my weed is gas. First of all bro all my weed is top shelf weed". At 1807 hours, the decedent responded "Yeah I know I dealt with you I know it's fire. I'm saying to make my cash back. I didn't mean it in any way I'm sorry my g". At 1808

hours, the contact responded with two unknown media messages and then stated "Yea you can. If u grab like the sour or white Tahoe. That to is gas. All I sell white Tahoe really \$50 a 8th but I got so much pounds. I said fuck it". At 1810 hours the decedent stated "I want the top 3". The contact replied "Wym. Top 3 what It's a hard choice". At 1819 hours the decedent said "I want the truffles for a fact. What strain of truffles is it. 3 zips for 990 of designer"? At 1828 the contact replied "that's what you wan". The decedent replied and said "Do you got exotic bags that come with it"? The contact replied stated "Insane ice cream cake and mintz yes. I can give you 8 top shelf bags for the truffles". The decedent responded at 1830 hours stated "Ok I want the 3 zips of 50\$. If it comes with bags so I can put some together that will be perfect for me my dude. Which I hope it do". The contact responded at 1835 hours asking "when you coming for it"? The decedent replied "I got one oil change t do at the shop & I can take my break". The contact responded "Iight. I'm putting it together now". The decedent asked "That works for you"? to which the contact responded "So like a hr or sooner. Bro you mine as well make it \$1000 cause I'm giving you bags and everything". At 1847 hours the decedent responded stating "Whenever I'm done with this oil change I'll be on my way I'm in the middle of it now". 1k even. Ok you g". The contact responded "ok". At 1906 hours the decedent told the contact "Almost finished her & I'll be in routec". The contact replied "Iight". The decedent asked "Off Princeton still same spot"? The contact responded at 1919 hours "Bro I always have that A1 weed. [REDACTED] The decedent responded at 1921 hours "I'm leaving the shop now so I should be there in less than 10. You there my dude?" The suspect contact replied at 1926 hours "Yea bro waiting on you. Let me know when you outside". The decedent replied at 1926 hours "Ok coming down Princeton 3 mins". The suspect contact replied at 1926 hours

"Don't pull up blasting music". The decedent replied "Where you want me to park. In front of [REDACTED]". The suspect contact responded at 1927 hours "Yea that's my house". At 1928 hours, the decedent stated "pulling into Coventry now". At 1929 hours, the suspect contact replied "Ok. Can u come to my front door. What car u in, the rang". The suspect contact then attempted to call the decedent at 1935 hours. At 1935 hours, the decedent responded "I'm in a taxi. I'm here don't see anyone".

- L. On February 21, 2021, a conversation between the decedent and a phone number of [REDACTED] was observed. At 1756 hours, the decedent contacted the contact stating "Hey my guy. It's James the Jew kid from the oil shop in Monmouth in Lakewood. You got any flavors?" At 1758 hours, the suspect contact replied "What's good. I got a new number phone and new number to". The decedent responded at 1800 "You know who you talking to? It's james". The suspect contact replied at 1801 hours stating "I just texted you off my other phone". The decedent replied "Yeah got you. I' working so it took me a while to get what you was saying my bad g". At 1801 hours the suspect contact replied "Hit my other phone".
- M. On Monday, February 22, 2021, Detective Brant Uricks and this Affiant conducted a formal statement of Paris Wright. An abridged summary of the statement to the best of this affiant's recollection provided by Paris Wright is as follows: Mr. Wright advised he arrived at [REDACTED] this morning as he had been unable to contact anyone in his family. Wright advised that he stays there on occasion but has not been there for approximately the past week. Wright advised that his father Derrick Wright, his grandmother Kathleen Frank, his aunt Delfina Lawson, his cousin Jahvontae Debose, and until approximately a week ago, his brother Derrick Jarvis, son of Derrick Wright all live at the residence. Wright stated he believed that Derrick Jarvis has

since procured his own residence. Wright advised that his father's wife also lives on [REDACTED], not far from the scene. Wright believes her name is Julian Lawson. When asked if he had a contact number for Jahvontae Debose, Wright provided a phone number of [REDACTED]. Wright advised that the last time he messaged him was approximately a month ago and was unsure if it was a good number for him. Wright advised that that number was saved under the contact "Moo". Wright was subsequently shown a photo of Jahvontae Debose to which he positively identified him and initialed the photo. Wright also advised that he purchases edible marijuana from Jahvontae from that residence.

- N. On Monday February 22, 2021, Detective Brant Uricks and this Affiant formally interviewed Chaim Halpert. Halpert advised that he observed the decedent stumbling up and collapse in the street in front of his residence at [REDACTED]. Halpert informed the decedent Wright was asking for help and stated words to the effect of "they shot me". Halpert advised he asked another neighbor to contact 911 while he rendered aid to the decedent. No further information of evidentiary value was provided.
- O. On Monday February 22, 2021, Detective Uricks and this Affiant formally interviewed Aniylah Ewart. Ewart informed that she and the decedent have been dating for a few years on and off. Ewart stated she shares a child with the victim and the last she had seen him was on Sunday, February 21, at the Days Inn in Toms River where they stay frequently. Ewart stated the last time she saw him was approximately 1700 hours. Ewart further stated that the decedent did not state where he was going. Ewart said tried to contact him but was unable to positively make contact.
- P. On Monday February 22, 2021, Detective Uricks and this Affiant formally interviewed with James Yusupov. An abridged summary of the statement to the best of this affiant's recollection

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provided by Yusupov is as follows: Yusupov informed the detectives that he was at work on Sunday February 21, 2021 at Qual Care Automotive (2nd Street and Monmouth Avenue, Lakewood). While there, Yusupov stated a customer came in for an oil change. Yusupov advised that he smelled the odor of marijuana in the vehicle he was servicing. Yusupov made conversation with the customer about the odor and the customer identified himself as "Kamir Johnson". According to Yusupov, Johnson asked for a phone number of anyone in the area that sold marijuana. Yusupov stated that he and "Kamir Johnson" exchanged telephone numbers. Yusupov advised that he received a text from Johnson asking for the phone number of a marijuana dealer. Yusupov further stated he did not respond to the text and Johnson called his cell phone asking for the phone number of his marijuana dealer. Yusupov stated he provided Johnson with a phone number of a young black male in Coventry Square that he has purchased marijuana from in the past, but does not know his name. During the interview, Yusupov was displayed a photograph of the decedent, who he positively identified as "Kamir Johnson", the photo was of Dajour Randolph. Yusupov was displayed a photograph of Jahvontae Debose, who he identified as his marijuana dealer from Coventry Square. Yusupov signed both photographs. Further, Yusupov provided consent for his phone and said phone was given to the Ocean County High Tech Crimes Unit for a forensic examination.

Q. On Monday, February 22, 2021 at approximately 0010 hours, a Court authorized search warrant was executed at [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Said search warrant was executed with the assistance of the Lakewood Township Special Response Team. Upon the residence being secured, the residence was photographed and processed by members of the Ocean County Sheriff's Office, Crime Scene Investigations Unit. All items of evidentiary value were photographed and secured by the Ocean County Sheriff's Office Crime Scene Investigations

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Unit. Among the items seized by police were two (2) vacuum sealed bags containing green vegetative matter recovered from underneath the bed of the west bedroom, fourteen (14) packages labeled "Hiiwaiin Punch" containing liquid with 350 milligrams of THC collected from the west bedroom, two (2) packages with Instagram logo and labeled "@Mr_NiceGuys" containing liquid believed to be controlled dangerous substance collected from the west bedroom, one (1) plastic bag with various items believed to be controlled dangerous substances collected from under the bed in the west bedroom, one (1) brown bag containing various items believed to be controlled dangerous substances collected from the west bedroom. It should be noted that the west bedroom was identified as belonging to Jahvontae Debose by his mother Delfinda Lawson during her statement to police. A prescription bottle and various documents were also discovered by police in said bedroom with the name Jahvontae Debose.

- R. In addition to the abovementioned, police also collected one (1) Taurus firearm bearing serial number NE939491 collected from the north bedroom, one (1) Ruger firearm bearing serial number 662-38555 collected from the north bedroom, one (1) Taurus PT92AFS firearm bearing serial number TSC27525 collected from a safe in the north bedroom, one (1) empty gray in color Ruger gun case collected from the closet of the north bedroom, one (1) black long firearm with bayonet in case collected from the north bedroom closet, one (1) Colt Defender airsoft gun collected from the north bedroom, one (1) silver and black Powerline airsoft gun collected from the north bedroom, one (1) AK-47 with a seated magazine located in a black bag collected from the shed, one (1) rifle round collected from the north bedroom, one packaged extended magazine collected from the north bedroom, one (1) green metal box containing various live ammunition and firearms paperwork

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collected from the north bedroom, one (1) glass jar with a bag containing multiple rounds of .38 Special ammunition collected from the closet of the west bedroom, one (1) plastic bag containing multiple rounds of .38 Special ammunition collected from the west bedroom, one (1) plastic bag containing multiple rounds of .380 ammunition collected from a shoe box in the west bedroom, one (1) box of 9mm Winchester ammunition collected from the west bedroom, and one (1) box of .45 PMC ammunition collected from the west bedroom.

- S. On Monday, February 22, 2021, and Tuesday February 23, 2021, police responded to Tutor Court in Lakewood and obtained consent from approximately twenty-two (22) residents in the immediate area of the scene and where the victim was discovered for the search of the outdoor trash receptacles utilized by each resident. A search of approximately seventeen (17) of said receptacles yielded negative results for a firearm. Five (5) are currently pending search. Two (2) receptacles were unable to be identified as belonging to the residents. Said receptacles can be described as one (1) green in color trash receptacle with "417 # 0030687" stamped in white writing on the front of the receptacle and one (1) green in color trash receptacle with "417 # 0172286" stamped in white writing on the front of the receptacle.
- T. On Monday, February 22, 2021, at approximately 1800 hours, a postmortem examination was conducted on the body of Dajour Randolph. The examination, which took place at Community Medical Center, was conducted by Dr. Mazari of the Ocean County Medical Examiner's Office. The examination yielded the discovery of three (3) projectiles (unknown caliber). Said projectiles were collected from the left chest cavity, the left chest wall, and the left back. The projectiles are pending analysis and examination by the Ocean County Sheriff's Office Ballistics Unit. Dr. Mazari located three (3) entrance wounds on the decedent's body. Said wounds were

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located on the left chest, the left shoulder, and the left back.

U. Subsequent to the examination Dr. Mazari determined the cause of death of Dajour Randolph to be MULTIPLE GUNSHOT WOUNDS and the manner of death to be HOMICIDE.

V. [REDACTED]

W. Information was provided to police by Delfinda Lawsom during her taped statement that Jahvontae Debose is in a dating relationship with a female identified as Jasmine Pinkney. Lakewood Police conducted an in-house search for Pinkney and identified [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. Furthermore, Pinkney has a 2015 Nissan Sentra bearing New Jersey registration number [REDACTED]

X. On Monday, February 21, 2021, surveillance was established on Pinkney by members of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Narcotics Strike Force.

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- Y. On Tuesday, February 23, 2021, in the afternoon hours, Pinkney was surveilled leaving her apartment at the abovementioned address and travelling south bound on the Garden State Parkway. She subsequently travelled to the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Pinkney subsequently entered the same. Pinkney exited the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with a black male, believed to be Jahvontae Debose, and returned to her vehicle. Pinkney entered the front driver's seat and the black male entered the passenger seat. The vehicle then left the area.
- Z. A motor vehicle stop was subsequently conducted on the white Nissan Sentra bearing New Jersey registration number [REDACTED] on Fire Road near the intersection of Doughty Road in Egg Harbor Township. The driver of the vehicle was subsequently identified as Jasmine Pinkney and the passenger of the vehicle was identified as Jahvontae Debose. Pinkney and Debose were subsequently taken into custody.
- AA. On February 23, 2021, a Warrant for the arrest of Jahvontae Debose was approved. He was charged with the following criminal charges: N.J.S.A 2C:5-1A(1); N.J.S.A 2C:35-5B(11); N.J.S.A 2C:35-10A(3); N.J.S.A 2C:35-5A(1); N.J.S.A 2C:39-4.1A; N.J.S.A 2C:39-7B(1); N.J.S.A 2C:39-4A(1). 2021.
- BB. Detective Tony Sgro subsequently responded to the Quality Inn to speak with the manager of the hotel. The manager advised that Debose was staying in [REDACTED] of the hotel. The manager further advised that said hotel room was rented by Joshua Holland. It was further related that Holland checked in the hotel room on February 22, 2021, for two (2) adults, and was scheduled to check out on February 24, 2021.
- CC. This Affiant was advised that during the arrest of Jahvontae Debose, subsequent to the aforementioned motor vehicle stop, a cellular device fell to the ground outside of

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the passenger door of the vehicle. Said phone can be described as a red in color Apple iPhone with "iPhone" and "(Product)Red" written in white lettering on the back of the phone.

DD. Jahvontae Debose was subsequently transported to Lakewood police Headquarters to provide a taped statement. On February 23rd, 2021, This Affiant and Detective Uricks conducted a taped statement of Jahvontae Debose at the Lakewood Police Department. The following is an abridged summary of the statement provided by Jahvontae Debose: Jahvontae stated that earlier in the day he went to a jewelry store in Collingswood Flea Market. He advised that he came back around to the Lakewood area around six. He advised that he was with his cousin, Fejon, smoking weed in an unknown area of Lakewood until he left at approximately 2100 hours in an Uber heading down to the Pleasantville area. He advised that he was not at the residence during this time period. The subject terminated the interview around this time and no further questioning was conducted.

EE. On February 23rd, 2021, this Affiant and Detective Uricks conducted a taped statement with Jasmine Pinkney, the girlfriend of Jahvontae Debose. An abridged summary of the statement provided is as follows: Jasmine and Jahvontae have been dating for six or seven years. On Sunday the 21st, Jasmine was with Jahvontae until around 1800 hours, when he left, as she stated, with his cousin. She does not know which cousin picked him up and did not see him leave in the car. She advised that the evening after the shooting, Jahvontae went down to Pleasantville and stayed there until she picked him up from the Quality Inn to go to T-Mobile, when she was pulled over by law enforcement. She advised that he did not talk about the incident about his residence, but was familiar with what happened.

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FF. On February 23, 2021 Detective Nicole Testa applied for a Court authorized search warrant for the aforementioned motel room that Debose was known to be staying in. Said search warrant was approved by Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman and subsequently authorized by the Honorable Wendel E. Daniels, P.J.Cr.P.

GG. On February 23, 2021 Detective Nicole Testa applied for a Court authorized search warrant for the aforementioned apartment of Jasmine Pinkney at [REDACTED]. Said search warrant was approved by Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman and subsequently authorized by the Honorable Wendel E. Daniels, P.J.Cr.P.

HH. On February 23, 2021 Detective Nicole Testa applied for a Court authorized search warrant for the aforementioned vehicle of Jasmine Pinkney, more specifically described as a White 2015 Nissan Sentra bearing New Jersey registration number [REDACTED]. Said search warrant was approved by Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman and subsequently authorized by the Honorable Wendel E. Daniels, P.J.Cr.P.

II. A search of the White 2015 Nissan Sentra bearing New Jersey registration [REDACTED] was conducted pursuant to the aforementioned search warrant. A search of said vehicle yielded the collection of one (1) purple iPhone 11 in a green case, found on the driver's side air conditioning vent holder and one (1) black in color Apple iPhone with the word "iPhone" in black lettering on the back of the phone and with a cracked screen and backing recovered from the center console cup holder.

JJ. On Tuesday, February 23, 2021, the aforementioned search warrant [REDACTED] was executed. Upon entrance to the motel room, law enforcement encountered

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Joshua Holland who was renting the motel room. Detective Sergeant John Carroll advised Holland that his phone would be seized for investigative purposes. Sergeant Carroll asked Holland if he was willing to consent to the search of his cellular device to which Holland declined. The cellular device, a white in color Apple iphone in a black case with a cracked screen was subsequently seized pending application to the Court for a search warrant. Said device was turned over to the High Tech Crimes Unit.

KK. On Tuesday, February 23, 2021, a Court authorized search warrant [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] rented by Joshua Holland was executed. One (1) black in color LG smartphone was recovered from a book bag during the execution of said search warrant. Said device was seized pending application to the Court for a search warrant. Said device was turned over to the High Tech Crimes Unit.

LL. On Monday, February 22, 2021, the aforementioned search warrant of [REDACTED] was executed. During the execution of the search warrant, the following devices were seized pending application to the Court for a search warrant. The devices were subsequently turned over to the High Tech Crimes Unit:

one (1) gold in color Samsung cell phone with a cracked screen and a black case covering the sides and back of the phone recovered from a shoe in the north bedroom, one (1) white in color Samsung cell phone in a yellow and black case covering the back and sides of the phone, recovered from the north bedroom, one (1) black in color Motorola cell phone which was recovered from the top drawer of the west bedroom, one (1) Alcatel black in color cell phone recovered from the east bedroom north nightstand, one (1) blue in color Samsung cell phone recovered from the coffee table in the living room.

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MM. On Wednesday, February 24, 2021, the results from the digital cellular extraction of the cellular device belonging to Jahvontae Debose were reviewed by Detective Denis Mitchell. During the review of the information, Detective Mitchell was able to view location data of the device at the time of the murder, revealing that the suspect, Jahvontae Debose, was in fact located in the immediate area of 166 Tudor Court, Lakewood, New Jersey.

NN. On Thursday, February 25, 2021, Detective Brant Uricks and this Affiant conducted a taped statement with Jasmine Pinkney at the Lakewood Township Police Department. During the interview, Jasmine was read her Miranda rights directly from a Lakewood Police Department Miranda rights waiver. Jasmine understood the form, signed the form, and agreed to provide a statement. During the statement, Jasmine provided information in reference to a conversation she had with Jahvontae Debose on February 21, 2021 at approximately 1940 hours. During the conversation, Jahvontae told Jasmine that he needed her, and that he just shot someone. She provided a possible location of where he said he hid the firearm he used in the shooting. The area was described as the "cut", which she knew from previous conversations to be hole cut into the fence that separated the Coventry Square development, from the Pinewood apartment complex.

OO. On Thursday, February 25, 2021, Jasmine Pinkney returned to the Lakewood Police Department and wanted to provide additional information that she did not relay in the earlier interview. Detective Brant Uricks and this Affiant spoke with Jasmine, and confirmed that she did sign the Miranda form presented to her in the earlier interview, and she still understood her rights. Jasmine confirmed that she understood, and that she wished to speak to us. During this interview, Jasmine informed us that during their conversation on February 21, 2021 at 1940 hours,

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Jahvontae stated that the firearm he used in the shooting did not leave behind any shell casings. It should be noted, from my training and experience, I am familiar with this type of firearm to be known as a "Revolver". It should also be noted that there were no shell casings located at the scene of [REDACTED] Jasmine also informed us that people have attempted to "rob" Jahvontae in the past, this is why he was in possession of a firearm.

PP. On Thursday, February 25, 2021, the Lakewood Police Department, Ocean County Prosecutors Office, and the Ocean County Sheriffs Department responded to the area mentioned above as the "cut". Ocean County Sheriffs Department Detective Casulo and her K-9 partner Bear (an explosive detection K-9) conducted an open air search of the area. During the search, K-9 Bear showed interest in the area of a hollowed out tree, directly next to an opening cut in the fence between Coventry Square and the Pinewood Apartments. Detective Kevin Donnelly of the Lakewood township Police Department was in the area and began to search the area, where he located a revolver style firearm hidden between the wooden stockade fence along Coventry Square and the chain link fence along the Pinewood Apartments. The firearm located is a .38 special Smith & Wesson five shot revolver, which contained three "Hornady" spent cartridges, one "Federal" spent cartridge, and one live "Federal" ball lead round. The firearms serial number was intentionally defaced, where the first character of the serial number was identified as a "C", no other characters were identifiable.

QQ. The aforementioned information was presented to Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman who authorized charges for Murder 2C:11-3a(1) and (2).
