Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On 12/31/20, I (Det. Farnkopf #230) responded to Wawa (116 Brick Blvd) in reference to a Det. D. Kenny #253 being struck by a vehicle that was fleeing the scene of a drug transaction. On arrival, I spoke with the Wawa manager, who accessed the surveillance videos. In the video, two males, later identified as Ryan Chapman and Robert Brennan, are seen exiting the Wawa and entering into a blue Honda Civic (NJ Reg [REDACTED]). That vehicle also was occupied by the driver, later identified as Jill Farrelly. Chapman entered and sat in the front passenger seat, and Brennan sat in the rear passenger seat, directly behind Chapman. Moments later, Brennan exits the vehicle and walks across the parking lot. At that time, Det. Kenny is observed on the surveillance video walking up to the passenger side of the Honda Civic, where Det. Kenny observed Chapman injecting his arm with a loaded hypodermic syringe containing suspect heroin. Det. Kenny, wearing his police badge on a chain in view and hanging from his neck, identified himself as a Police Officer to Chapman and Farrelly, and asked them to lower the window to speak with him. The occupants refused to open the window, and the driver put the vehicle in drive and fled. Due to the vehicle fleeing, Det. Kenny's sweatshirt was stuck on the passenger's mirror of the vehicle, which ultimately led to the vehicle dragging Det. Kenny approximately ten feet before striking the ground, causing injury to Det. Kenny's arms, legs, and back. The vehicle is then observed on a different surveillance camera driving at a high rate of speed and recklessly through the Wawa parking lot before entering onto Brick Blvd (southbound).

While at Police Headquarters, Jill Farrelly and Ryan Chapman were both read their Miranda Rights and both agreed to videotaped interviews. During the interviews, both stated they were part of a heroin transaction in the Wawa parking lot, and that Chapman was using heroin at or around the time Det. Kenny approached the vehicle. Both also stated Chapman told Farrelly to drive away when approached by Det. Kenny.
