Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On Tuesday, February 19th, 2019 at approximately 1416 hours, DSgt. Petrola #201 from the Brick Township Drug Enforcement Unit (DEU) and this writer Detective Puccio #259 from the Ocean County Narcotics Strike Force (OCNSF) were in an undercover capacity and in the area of Route 88 and John Street. While in the area, I observed a black Chevrolet SUV bearing New Jersey registration [REDACTED] parked at the Speedway Gas Station located at 1672 Route 88. I observed a white female driver who I identified as Megan Bornemann and the passenger to be George Murray Sr. [REDACTED]

A patrol officer was in the area and conducted a motor vehicle stop on this vehicle on the ramp leading to parkway north off of Burrsville Road. [REDACTED] he was placed under arrest without incident. I read Murray his rights per Miranda and asked him if there was anything illegal in the vehicle which he stated he understood his rights and stated he was not sure of any CDS in the vehicle. I spoke with Bornemann and asked her for consent to search of her vehicle. Bornemann stated she did not want to provide consent to search of the vehicle and Sgt. Catalina #229 with his K9 partner Duke arrived on scene. K9 Duke was deployed on the vehicle for a narcotics sniff and had a positive indication. A search of the vehicle contained; eight (8) mg/2mg Suboxone sublingual films in the glove box, three and a half (3.5) brown oblong pills stamped "A 60" identified as Mirtazapine 30 in a white bottle without a label or prescription and sixteen (16) round pink pills stamped "JSP 562" identified as Unithroid 112 mcg by Drugs.com in a plastic baggie without a prescription label or prescription. Bornemann was then read her rights per Miranda and asked if the CDS located in her vehicle was hers and she stated the pills are hers but the Suboxone was not hers. She was unable to provide a valid prescription for either pills located in the vehicle. Ocean County Narcotics Strike Force case #190200173
