AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR ARREST WARRANT

Detective Sean D. Flynn, of full age, being duly sworn according to law upon their oaths, depose and say:

1. I am currently employed as a Detective with the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office, Special Operations Group.

2. In the course of my duties I have conducted investigations regarding, but not limited to, Distribution of and Possession with the Intent to Distribute Controlled Dangerous Substances and Conspiracy to commit the foregoing offenses.

3. I have probable cause to believe and do believe that **Carlos Sanchez** committed the crime listed herein:

4. The basis for my probable cause is as follows:

On Wednesday, February 3, 2016, this Affiant applied for, and was granted a search warrant for the residence of Carlos Sanchez located at 1699 West Princeton Avenue, Brick Township, New Jersey by the Honorable Wendel E. Daniels, P.J.Cr.P.

During the morning of Thursday, February 4, 2016, the above referenced search warrant was executed at 1699 West Princeton Avenue. Located within the residence at the time of the search warrant was Carlos Sanchez. At that time, Carlos Sanchez was advised of his rights, per Miranda, which he stated he understood and wished to cooperate with our investigation. At this time, Carlos Sanchez spoke with this Affiant and stated that there was a quantity of cocaine, paraphernalia, and US currency located in a black bag at 1729 West Princeton Avenue, the residence of his parents Rosa and Carlos Sanchez. This Affiant then responded directly to 1729 West Princeton Avenue with Carlos Sanchez. Additionally, during

the search of his residence (1699 West Princeton Avenue), investigators located less than fifty grams of marijuana along with paraphernalia.

This Affiant then made contact with Rosa and Carlos Sanchez and subsequently received consent to search the residence as well as a black bag located within the residence. This search resulted in the discovery of greater than one half ounce but less than five ounces of cocaine along with paraphernalia and a quantity of assorted US currency.

Carlos Sanchez was then taken into custody without incident and was transported to the Brick Township Police Department. Once at the Brick Township Police Department, Carlos Sanchez was interviewed and provided a taped statement admitting ownership of the cocaine, paraphernalia, and US currency located at 1729 West Princeton Avenue.

5. A check of the NJMVC files revealed a Carlos Sanchez, 1699 W. Princeton Ave, Brick, New Jersey 08724, New Jersey Driver's License number [REDACTED], a Date of Birth of 08/26/1979 and a SSN of [REDACTED]

6. Based on the above, this affiant has probable cause to believe and does believe that **Carlos Sanchez** has violated the following New Jersey Statute:

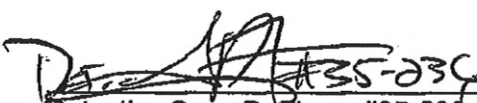
A. NJSA 2C:35-10a(1); knowingly possess greater than one half ounce but less than five ounces of cocaine, a crime of the Third degree.

B. NJSA 2C:35-5b(2); knowingly possess with the intent to distribute greater than one half ounce, but less than five ounces of cocaine, a crime of the Second degree.

C. NJSA 2C:35-10a(4); knowingly possess less than fifty grams of marijuana, a disorderly persons offence.

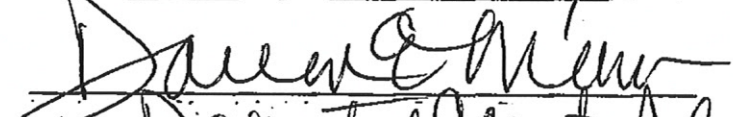
D. NJSA 2C:36-2; knowingly possess CDS paraphernalia, a disorderly persons offence.

Therefore, I respectfully request the Court to issue a warrant for the arrest of **Carlos Sanchez** for the aforesaid crime.
