Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

Liam McAtasney confessed to a friend that he strangled the victim, SS, at her residence at 78 Ridge Terrace in Neptune City on December 2, 2016. This statement was recorded. The defendant explained that, after strangling her, he left her body in her home. He later contacted his roommate Preston Taylor, who agreed to move the victim to the outside of her home. McAtasney and Taylor eventually returned to the backyard of 78 Ridge Terrace, Neptune City, where Taylor had hid her in the bushes. They retrieved the victim's body from the backyard of the residence and put the victim in the front seat of her car and traveled to the Belmar Bridge. As they had agreed, Taylor then meet McAtasney at the bridge in a separate vehicle and they dumped her body into the water below. Taylor and the defendant then left the area in a car that Taylor had driven there. The victim's car was left on the top of the bridge where it was eventually recovered by police.

McAtasney further admitted that he had planned to kill the victim for approximately 6 months prior to December 2, 2016 so he could take money that the victim had recently come into possession of. McAtasney explained that on December 2, 2016, he traveled with the victim to her bank where she accessed her safety deposit box. They returned to her residence where he eventually strangled the victim, and removed a safe from her home and got approximately \$7000 from the same. McAtasney told his friend that he hid the money in Sandy Hook, NJ.

Preston Taylor gave a statement confirming the information above. He admitted to removing the body from the home to hide the body from the victim's family members who could have returned to the residence. Taylor also admitted to helping McAtasney dump the victim over the Belmar Bridge. It is believed that this was done to further obstruct police from finding the victim's body. Taylor took police to one location in Sandy Hook, NJ where he showed police the location of the safe that was hidden and the same was recovered. Taylor also took police to a second location in Shark River Park, where another safe was located.

Both McAtasney and Taylor were spoken to the first week of December 2017. Both of those interviews were recorded. During the interviews both McAtasney and Taylor lied to police regarding their knowledge and involvement with the

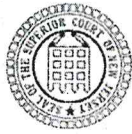

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the defendant is sentenced as follows:

COUNT 1: THE DEFENDANT IS COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR A TERM OF LIFE IMPRISONMENT, WITHOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF PAROLE, TO RUN CONCURRENT TO COUNTS 2 AND 7 AND CONSECUTIVE TO COUNT 5.

COUNT 2: THE DEFENDANT IS COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR A TERM OF 20 YEARS, TO RUN CONCURRENT TO COUNTS 1 AND 7 AND CONSECUTIVE TO COUNT 5. 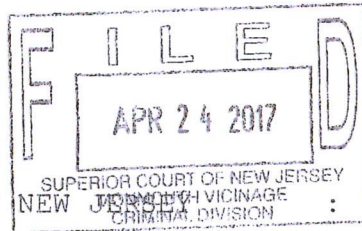

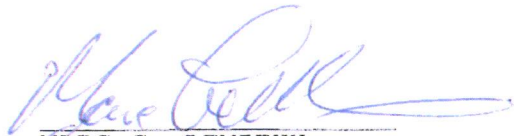

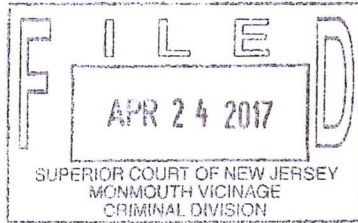
