APPENDIX A-AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

- A. On Thursday January 5, 2023 at approximately 1930 hours, members of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Major Crime Unit, Homicide Squad responded to the Brick Township Police Department in reference to a victim with multiple apparent stab wounds (Case #1293-23) found in the area of Cherry Quay Road, Brick Township, New Jersey. The victim was identified as [REDACTED], DOB: 04/15/1986. The victim was transported to Jersey Shore University Medical Center to be treated for her injuries.
- B. On today's date Thursday January 5, 2023 at approximately 1730 hours Officer Miller Badge #218 of the Brick Township Police Department was conducting a property check off of Cherry Quay Road, Brick Township, New Jersey. The location is specifically described as parking lot leading to a bike trail located at the end of the road off of Cherry Quay Road. Officer Miller observed a suspicious vehicle described as a red Nissan Sentra bearing New Jersey Registration: [REDACTED], registered to [REDACTED], DOB: 04/15/1986. The vehicle was unoccupied and had two flat tires. Officer Miller walked around the vehicle and observed an individual laying face down on the ground. Officer Miller made contact with the individual who was then identified as [REDACTED]. Officer Miller observed [REDACTED] covered with a blanket (on the lower part of her body) and with blood stains on the ground in the vicinity of the victim. When Officer Miller yelled out to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] responded with "My boyfriend Stabbed me". Officer Miller asked [REDACTED] where her boyfriend was and in response [REDACTED] answered "Harry Bray". Once Officer Miller observed that [REDACTED] was injured he contacted EMS and rendered aid. Additional Officer and EMS responded to the scene and continued to render aid to [REDACTED]. While on scene, [REDACTED] mentioned Harry Bray's name multiple times, specifically by saying his name as "Harry Bray Jr.". Officer Miller also observed a child car seat in the rear of the vehicle and confirmed with [REDACTED] that her daughter was currently at a daycare. Ultimately EMS transported [REDACTED] to Jersey Shore Medical Center. It should be noted that this writer and Detective Brylevskaya of the OCPO MCU reviewed the audio/video footage from Officer Miller's department issued Body Worn Camera and confirmed Officer Miller's observations with the events described above.
- C. Members of the Ocean County Sheriff's Department CSI Unit photographed and processed the scene of the incident. Items of evidentiary value were located/seized and transported to CSI lab for processing. It should be noted that Officers located and seized a silver in color engagement ring and a silver in color necklace with a heart pendant. Officer observed red stains consistent with blood on the jewelry. The jewelry was found on top of the garbage bags, which were located inside a garbage bin in the vicinity of the vehicle. The red Nissan Sentra was towed by the Ocean County vehicle services to an undisclosed secure location pending application of a search warrant.
- D. On the same date, this writer conducted a law enforcement database search of [REDACTED] and Harry Bray. This writer identified Harry Bray as Harry James Bray Jr., DOB: 07/12/1987. It was learned that both individuals were involved in a domestic violence incident in August of 2022. During the incident Mr. Bray stole [REDACTED] cell phone, a black Samsung. On the same date, this writer contacted Mr. Bray on telephone facility number [REDACTED] (telephone number attached to the DV incident). This writer asked Mr. Bray if he would be willing to come in to the police department in reference to an incident involving his girlfriend [REDACTED]. Mr. Bray agreed to speak with the Detectives and stated that he was currently at home located at 55 Pond Lane, Whiting (Manchester Township), New Jersey.

- E. Members of the Manchester Township Police department responded to 55 Pond Lane, Whiting, New Jersey and observed Mr. Bray on the steps leading up to the front entrance of the residence. Officers observed two vehicles parked outside of the residence: a blue 1994 Ford Ranger, bearing NJ Registration: [REDACTED] and a black 2011 Jeep Grand Cherokee, bearing NJ Registration: [REDACTED]. Both vehicles are registered to Harry Bray, of 55 Panda Lane, Whiting, New Jersey. Subsequently, Detective Bromley of the OCPO Major Crime Unit made contact with Mr. Bray who agreed to come to the Manchester Township Police Department to provide a statement. Mr. Bray's father, identified as Harry Bray Sr. drove Mr. Bray to the Manchester Township Police Department utilizing the black 2011 Jeep Cherokee. Prior to Bray departing the residence, Officers recovered two cellphones from his person, a black Galaxy S9 plus cell phone and a black Samsung cell phone. The cell phones were seized and secured pending application of search warrants.
- F. On the same date, this writer and Detective Brylevskaya interviewed [REDACTED] mother, identified as Deborah Phillips, DOB: 12/28/1961, while located at the Brick Township Police Department. The interview was audio and video recorded. In summary Ms. Phillips stated that her daughter [REDACTED] recently ended a dating relationship with Mr. Harry Bray. [REDACTED] and Bray began dating approximately one and a half year ago. Phillips stated that in the beginning of the relationship Mr. Bray was very nice to [REDACTED] and her 2 year old daughter and did a lot for them. After some time Phillips indicated that [REDACTED] found out that Bray was lying to her about many things. Phillips also stated that few months go her daughter called her in panic and told her that Bray and [REDACTED] got into an argument and Bray left the area in her vehicle with her daughter in it. There were also other incidents that [REDACTED] described to her mother as alarming in regard to Bray. At that point [REDACTED] decided to end the relationship. Bray kept contacting [REDACTED] even though [REDACTED] asked him not to. At one point [REDACTED] blocked Bray's phone number and on Facebook messenger in attempt to prevent him from contacting her. Phillips stated that before Christmas Bray left gifts for [REDACTED] and Phillips outside of Phillip's residence located in Toms River. Phillips indicated that she saw her daughter last night (01/04/2023) when they met for dinner and that is the last time they spoke. Phillips stated that on today's date she attempted to call her daughter on her cell phone three times at approximately 1700 hours but her daughter did not answer. Phillips received a call from her granddaughter's daycare who advised her that [REDACTED] never came to pick up her daughter. Phillips mentioned that [REDACTED] would never leave her daughter at the daycare. When Detective Brylevskaya asked Phillips what she thinks happened to her daughter, Phillips immediately said that she had Bray in mind, as the person who could have done this to her daughter. At the conclusion of the interview, Detective Brylevskaya presented Phillips with OCPO Digital Evidence Consent to search for [REDACTED] cell phone. Phillips signed the form and granted consent search of the [REDACTED] cell phone.
- G. On Thursday January 5, 2023 Detective Brylevskaya telephonically applied for court authorized search warrants for the following: Bray's residence located at 55 Panda Lane, Whiting (Manchester Township), New Jersey (including but not limited to the garbage cans and a shed located outside of the residence), a vehicle describe as a blue 1994 Ford Ranger, bearing NJ Registration: [REDACTED], a vehicle described as a black 2011 Jeep Grand Cherokee, bearing NJ Registration: [REDACTED], a black Galaxy S9 plus cell phone, a black Samsung cell phone, and physical exemplars in the form of major case prints, DNA samples via buccal swab of the

suspect. The search warrants were telephonically authorized and approved by the Honorable Judge Kimarie Rahill, J.S.C on January 5, 2023 at approximately 2206 hours.

- H. On the same date law enforcement members executed the court authorized search warrant on the residence located at 55 Panda Lane, Whiting (Manchester Township), New Jersey. Members of the OCSO CSI Unit photographed and processed the scene. Officers observed red stains consistent with blood on the door knob of the exterior door located at the rear of the residence. During the execution of the search warrant the following items of evidentiary value were collected/seized: swabs of red staining consistent with blood on the door knob on the rear door of the residence, a "Milwaukee" knife with a red and black plastic handle inside a black in color "Milwaukee" sheath case with red stains consistent with blood on the blade, found inside the garbage can outside of the residence, one receipt from "Home Depot" Store (located at 1900 Shorrock Road, Lakewood, NJ) dated 12/30/2022 12:47 PM for the following items: MKE DUCT KNIFE FOR 21.97 DOLLARS, HSKY FLDNG LKBK RZR UTLTY KNIFE/HOST FOR 8.97 DOLLARS, and other miscellaneous items of evidentiary value.
- I. On the same date Detective Bromley and Detective Byrne of the Brick Township Police Department conducted an interview of Harry Bray Jr., while located at the Manchester Township Police Department. The interview was audio and video recorded. Detectives read Bray his rights per Miranda. Bray stated that he understood his rights and agreed to speak with the Detectives. While speaking with Bray in regards to the events surrounding the incident, Bray requested to speak to a lawyer as soon as Detectives mentioned that a knife was located at his residence. The interview was immediately terminated. It should be noted that the Detectives observed what appeared to be cuts/defensive wounds on Bray's hands. Bray was then transported to the Brick Township Police Department to be processed and fingerprinted.
- J. While located at the Manchester Township Police Department, Detectives spoke with Bray's father, Harry Bray Sr. The interview was audio and video recorded. In summary Bray stated that his son's vehicle (Jeep Liberty) broke down earlier in the day. Bray stated that he picked up his son in Toms River and drove him back to their residence located at 55 Panda Lane, Whiting (Manchester), NJ. Bray further indicated that at approximately 1400 hours his son asked he could borrow his vehicle (Jeep Cherokee) to go to a job interview in Lakewood. Bray stated that his son returned to the residence at approximately 1730 hours.
- K. As a result of the investigation Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman approved the following charges against Harry James Bray Jr.: Attempted Murder in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C: 5-1A(1)-2C:11-3A(1), Unlawful Possession of a Weapon in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C: 39-5D, and Possession of a Weapon for Unlawful Purposes in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C: 39-4D.
