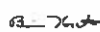

Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On 1/26/19, at 0222 hrs, Toms River Police responded to 113 Bash Road in reference to an unresponsive 46 year old male, identified as Brian Hemmes. TRPD and Medics responded to the residence. The victim was pronounced dead at 0237 hrs by Dr. Mathews of Newark Beth Israel Hospital.

Ms. Jacquelyn Tindall, Hemmes' fiancée, called Det Santora (TRPD) in regards to finding 2 blue pills at their residence. The pills were subsequently picked up by TRPD and submitted to the Ocean County Sheriff's Department. The 2 blue round blue pills marked "M" "30" recovered from 113 Bash Road, Toms River, were examined and tested positive for fentanyl.

On 2/7/19, the undersigned and Detective Santora conducted a taped statement of Samuel Crist. Crist said that on 1/25/19, he went over to the decedent's residence after work. Christ went with Hemmes to Paul's house. Hemmes told Crist that Paul stated earlier that he had "blues" for them. While inside of Paul's home, Crist stated that he and the decedent each received 3 "blues" for approximately \$30 each. Crist stated that Hemmes broke off a piece of one of the pills and ingested it nasally off of the kitchen counter in Paul's home. Crist said he broke of a piece of one of his three pills and chewed and swallowed it. Crist and the decedent went back to the decedent's house following the transaction.

On 2/12/19, the undersigned and Detective Brant Uricks conducted a taped statement of John Brennan. Brennan stated that he worked for the decedent and was with him throughout the day on Friday, 1/25, working in Newark. The decedent called Keith Paul, in a conversation that was heard by Brennan over the car speakers through Bluetooth. Paul further stated that he had "blues" for the decedent.

On 2/17/2019 Peter Paul contacted Det Uricks via cell phone. Paul advised that he wanted to receive the toxicology so that he could know exactly what killed his friend. Det Uricks advised that though the cause of death has yet to be determined, evidence suggests that fentanyl masked as percocet pills (blues) we a likely direct cause or contributing factor. Paul wanted to assure Det Uricks the he would never have knowingly supplied a Fentanyl pill to anyone, especially his friend.

On 2/26/19, the undersigned spoke with Dr. Siebert of the Ocean County Medical Examiner's Office in reference to the toxicology results of Brian Hemmes. Dr. Siebert advised that Hemmes death could be directly attributed to fentanyl ingestion.

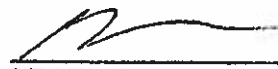
