To whom it may concern:

This office received a records request from you via email on Thursday, August 15, citing the New Jersey Open Public Records Act (OPRA) and the common-law right of access.

Specifically, you requested the following records pertaining to defendants you identified as Julie Rizzitello, Shane Dempsey, and Allison Havemann-Niedrach:

1. *"Arrest reports;*
2. *CAD reports with narratives;*
3. *Preliminary law enforcement incident reports (PLEIRs);*
4. *Complaint warrants;*
5. *Complaint summonses;*
6. *Affidavits of probable cause (the document used to detail the probable cause basis for a criminal complaint);*
7. *Indictments;*
8. *Plea forms; and*
9. *Judgments of conviction."*

As it pertains to your request for item No. 1, attached to this email please find copies of Wall Township Police Department Arrest Report No. 202402186, Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office Arrest Report No. MCP2400348, and Freehold Borough Police Department Arrest Report No. 24BK05450.

As it pertains to your request for items Nos. 2, 5, and 7-9, please be advised that a search of our records did not reveal any materials responsive to these elements of your request.

As it pertains to your request for items Nos. 3-4 and 6, attached to this email please find copies of Monmouth County Superior Court Complaint-Warrant Nos. 1307-W-2024-000093, 1315-W-2024-000181, 1316-W-2024-000248, 1316-W-2024-000252, 1352-W-2024-000314, 1352-W-2024-000345, 1506-W-2024-000569, and 1506-W-2024-000614, along with their corresponding PLEIRs and affidavits of probable cause.

Please note that very limited portions of Complaint-Warrant No. 1316-W-2024-000248 have been redacted in accordance with the OPRA exemptions outlined in C.47:1A-1.1, Definitions, specifically the portion that exempts from disclosure “security measures and surveillance techniques which, if disclosed, would create a risk to the safety or persons, property, electronic data or software.”

Please note that limited portions of all the documents being disclosed have also been redacted in order to omit personal identifying information, the release of which would violate an individual’s or individuals’ personal rights to privacy.
