Hello Mr. Gorski,

I hope all is well.

I wanted to give you an update on the water/sewer connection process.

On October 25, 2022, we met with the city engineer, Ryan Herkert and our engineer, Joe Hanrahan from Hammer Land Engineering to review utility maps.

At this time, our surveyor, Thomas Ernst is in the process of compiling all the necessary information to finalize the survey needed by our engineer in order to provide connection plans.

Please be advised that contrary to my statement in my March 18, 2022 letter, Barclay Brook's parking lot will not be affected as we will be using directional drilling for the connection with a meter pit installed at the curb.

I am aware the Board of Education is waiting for the actual connection plans from me. But at this point, I am not able to move forward incurring expenses for engineers, surveyors and contractors until I received a conditional confirmation from the Board that this work will be approved contingent on the submission of the engineer's plans.
