On 11/8/2024 at approximately 1227 hours. Police responded to the Cadbury Retirement Center (2150 Rt 38 W) for a reported assault. The caller stated a food service director, Jahneal Sanders , struck one of the facility managers, Joseph Custis, in the face.

Upon arrival I spoke with facility administrator Jason Scherfel regarding the incident. Jason stated Jahneal was in the facility to speak with staff regarding recent performance. Jason advised at some point during the meeting Jahneal and Joseph engaged in a disagreement over how Jahneal was speaking to the staff. Jahneal asked Joseph to come speak in his office, at which point Jahneal struck Joseph in his face area with a closed fist. Jason advised there was no video recordings of the incident.

I spoke with Joseph via in house recorded line to get his account of the incident. Joseph advised of the meeting and stated he and Jahneal had a disagreement as he didn't feel the staff was being spoken to in a respectful way. Joseph advised he and Jahneal went to the office and as they entered the room Jahneal struck him from behind. I sent Joseph an Axon Citizen's invite to upload pictures of his injuries.

Joseph stated he wished to pursue criminal complaints and was advised of the proper process to do so.

On 11/9/24 at approximately 1443 hours, police responded to 2000 Rt 38, Cherry Hill Mall, at the Pin Straight Kiosk for a report of a disturbance. The caller advised there was a customer dispute at Pin Straight. Upon arrival, P/O Bruno #474 and I made contact with Tina Brandt and Nicole Shorter. Brandt and Shorter were both on location to initiate a return at Pin Straight and advised that the product they purchased did not work. Pin Straight employees were not on location at the time police arrived and had left the area when Brandt called police.

Brandt stated that she purchased a hair straightener yesterday 11/9/24 for \$200. She purchased it for her granddaughter after watching a demonstration and then took the product home and it did not work the same way. Brandt returned on today's date to return the product and staff advised they could not return the product or refund any money. Brandt indicated that the Pin Straight employee only advised that there was no refunds possible, after her credit card was charged. As Brandt was speaking with a Pin Straight employee, Shorter arrived on location with her products.

Shorter advised she purchased a hair straightener for her daughter approximately 2 weeks ago and was charged \$150 plus given several other free products. Shorter encountered the same issue that the product did not work once she returned home. Shorter stated that she was never advised that Pin Straight did not offer refunds when her credit card was charged. Shorter explained that she had already searched online for reviews and found similar reviews and an article involving the Better Business Bureau. She stated she already emailed Pin Straight customer service and they ceased communication with her approximately 1 week ago without providing a solution.

An employee from the second Pin Straight kiosk responded to the scene. P/O Bruno spoke with the Pin Straight manager on an uninvolved employee's phone who was advised to initiate the refund to the customers. The manager was not cooperative and argued that he could not refund any money anymore. Eventually, the manager agreed to have Brandt and Shorter send the customer service email a picture of their receipt and he would try to refund their money. The employee also showed P/O Bruno a video of that an employee putting a phone up, toward Brandt's face and she pushed it away from her. No other manager or employee information was provided and there was little cooperation.

Brandt and Shorter were provided with a case number and advised they would contact police if there continued to be an issue and they did not receive a refund. Both parties wished for the incident to be documented so they could provide a report to their credit card companies to dispute the purchases. All parties left the area without incident.

Standard advised that she had ordered an Uber on this date for \$22.67. She stated that she gave the driver, Marco Louissaint, specific instructions in regards to where she was to be picked up. Standard stated when Louissaint arrived on location to pick her up, that he did not follow the instructions that she specifically gave him. That then led to a verbal argument between the two and Standard wished to receive a refund for the ride. She stated in order to do so that Louissaint needed to cancel the ride.

Louissaint ultimately canceled the ride and left the scene without incident. Standard stated she had received a refund from Uber for only \$6.00, not the full amount which was \$22.67. Standard was advised she needed to contact Uber to settle the dispute over the refund. She was also advised that the incident was going to be documented and she was provided with a case number card.

On 11/13/2024 at approximately 1945 hours, P/O Sost #462 and I responded to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] For a report of a person with a weapon. Upon arrival, I spoke to Stephen Shook, who advised he was involved in a physical altercation with a neighbor down the street. The neighbor was later identified as Jamar Harris-Zeigler.

Shook stated he was driving his vehicle down Holden Road when Harris-Zeigler blocked him from proceeding forward. Shook states both parties had a verbal exchange and Harris-Zeigler got out of his vehicle and punched him. Shook advises Harris-Zeigler punched him with a closed fist, three times on the left side of his face, then went back to his residence. [REDACTED]

Harris-Zeigler stated Shook was driving home from the dollar store when he was approached by Shook, in regards to a road rage incident. Harris-Zeigler reported Shook became irate and followed him home. Harris-Zeigler advised Shook approached him, in front of his residence, with a pocket knife and Harris-Zeigler pushed him away. He ran into his residence and Shook left to his residence.

Detective Daniello #350 responded and took taped statements from both parties (see supplement). The investigation was turned over to Detective Daniello for further.

I was contacted by Sgt. Jones #377 who advised me a Detective was needed to respond to Holden Road in regards to this incident. I responded to [REDACTED] where I spoke with Jamar Harris-Ziegler. I asked him to explain to me in detail what happened with regards to this incident. He advised he was on his way home and encountered Stephen Shook in the neighborhood. He explained he was initially stopped at a Stop sign on the street, at which time Shook attempted to drive around his car. Jamar then proceeded forward and they almost collided, at which time a brief verbal altercation ensued. Jamar then left and drove home. Once at home he exited his car at which time he observed Shook pull up in front of his house and exit his car while brandishing a knife in his hand. He then approached Jamar with the knife in his hand, at which time Jamar began pushing him. After doing so Jamar retreated into his house.

He described the knife as a pocketknife and stated Shook had the knife in his right hand. I asked him if he punched Shook at any point and he said he did not. He indicated he only pushed Shook with open hands.

I then spoke with Jamar's grandmother, Avaretta Davis, and asked her to explain to me what she observed during this incident. She said he was inside of her house and noticed Jamar pull into their driveway, at which time she proceeded to open the front door. Once she did so she observed Jamar and Shook involved in a dispute. She indicated she could see something in Shook's hand but was not sure what it was. At that point she yelled for Jamar to get inside the house and he complied.

It should be noted there have been a number of incidents involving both families over the past several months.

After speaking with Avaretta and Jamar I secured from their residence and responded to 19 Holden Road where I spoke with Stephen Shook. I advised him I was investigating this incident and asked him to explain to me in detail what happened. He stated he was driving to [REDACTED] when he attempted to pass Jamar, who was stopped in his car in the street. He said when he attempted to pass Jamar, Jamar began driving forward and nearly collided with Shook's vehicle. Shook then shouted at Jamar, who then responded by saying: "You're from [REDACTED]..... I'll see you...." He added that when he continued on his way he encountered Jamar a second time when Jamar stopped his car on Holden, jumped out and stopped Shook's vehicle. Shook then exited his car at which time Jamar punched him three times in his face. Shook had a visible knot on the left side of his face, consistent with being punched in the face.

Both Shook and Jamar were explained the process for signing complaints against each other. They were also advised that there would be no complaints signed by CHPD in regards to this incident.

This case is Exceptionally Cleared.

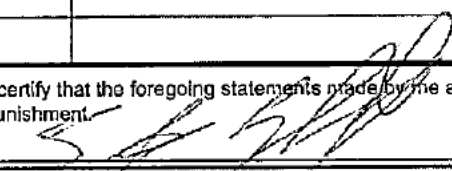

I received a phone call from Tanise Tricoche [REDACTED] who stated she and her sister, Syniyah Sye [REDACTED] were involved in an altercation at Vera on 11/16/24 at approximately 0130 hours in front of the building.

Tanise stated a group of unknown individuals approached her and Syniyah and accused them of stealing a cellphone. Tanise denied stealing a phone, and an argument then ensued which resulted in an unidentified Hispanic male striking Syniyah in the face with a closed fist. Tanise stated she and her sister then proceeded into their vehicle (NJ: [REDACTED] and left the area. Nuzzi observed the offender enter a newer black Honda Accord and believed the license plate to be [REDACTED]. A DMV inquiry of the registration revealed that it belonged to a 1972 Brown Dodge Coupe.

I then spoke with the Women's Center manager, Kristen Daskilewicz, to retrieve video footage of the incident. Daskilewicz advised she does not have access to the cameras, and to contact head of security, Amanda Kifferty [REDACTED] to obtain surveillance footage of the incident.
