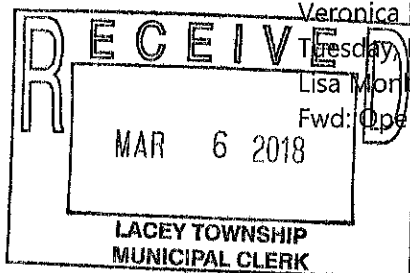

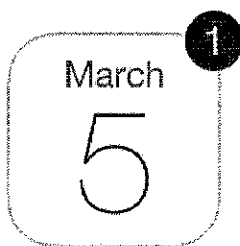

The County anticipates that all towers will be fully constructed and operational by the 4th Quarter of 2018. 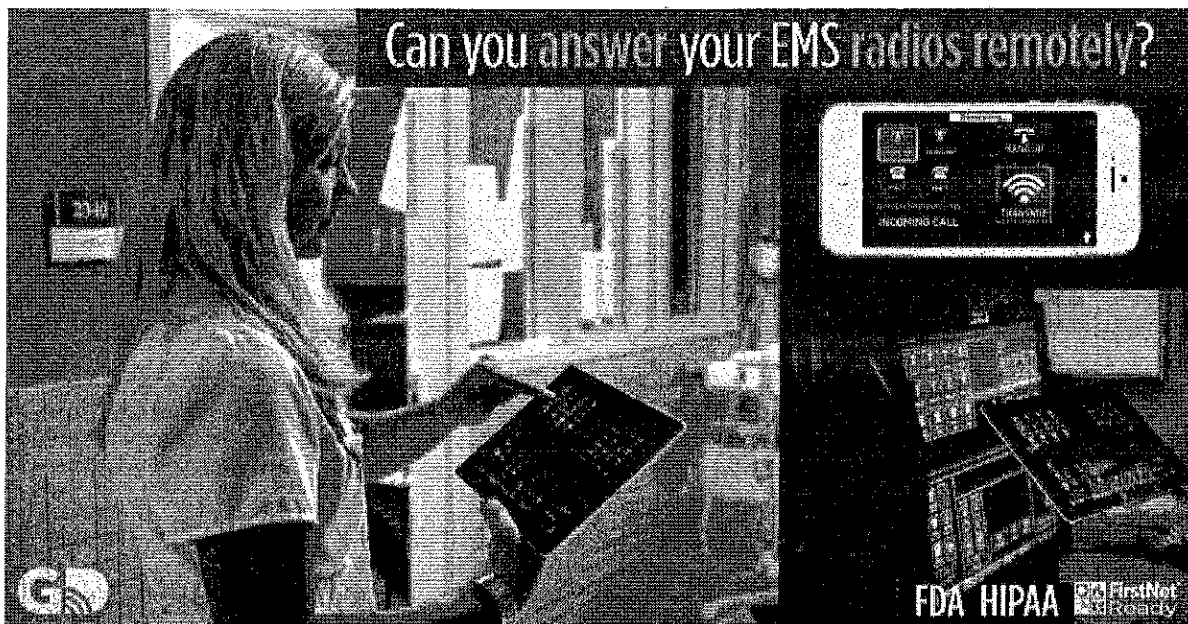

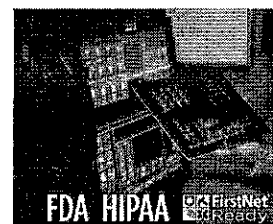
