WHEREAS, on December 30, 2022, Moline was served with a Preliminary Notice of Disciplinary Action seeking to impose discipline; and

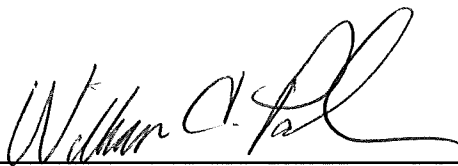
WHEREAS, Moline requested an administrative hearing on the charge; and

WHEREAS, upon the advice of Special Labor Counsel, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to resolve this matter without the need for future litigation; and

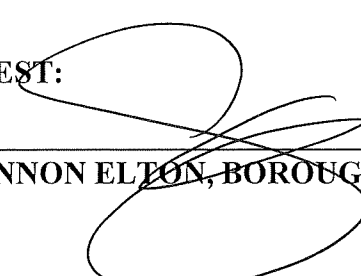
WHEREAS, in conjunction therewith, the parties will need to execute a Settlement Agreement;

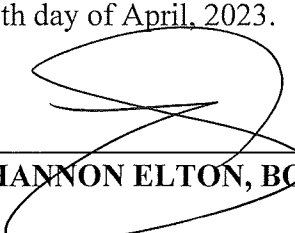

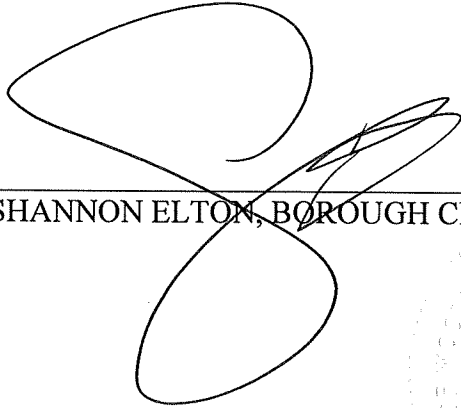
