Chief – tried to reach out to you the other day on this but we could not connect.

We have begun rolling out Lifelines Treatment Program/Cuffs to Beds at local police departments – it is now “live” and up and running. It’s my understanding that – as of now – there has been no referrals yet from your department.

We have previously updated our Bail Reform guidelines to allow local departments to place complaints related to indictable possession of CDS on a summons, rather than a warrant, without obtaining Assistant Prosecutor approval. See attached documents (specifically page 4 of the Implementation of Bail Reform Policy). This will result in a greater number of drug offenders being released directly from the local department without any additional conditions (like treatment) being placed on them. **These are precisely the type of addicted offenders that should be encouraged into treatment through a program like Lifelines.**

Please advise your officers that when they come across an addicted offender who is being released on a summons to inquire whether he/she is interested in treatment. If so, you should **immediately contact Lifelines at (609) 357-5086** so they can dispatch a recovery specialist to speak with the defendant and begin plans for treatment.

Prosecutors will take into account those who cooperate and successfully complete treatment when determining the appropriate disposition of their charges.
