APPENDIX A - AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

- A. On Friday, April 2, 2021, Stafford Township Police responded to Southern Ocean Medical Center following a phone call from David Gregor in reference to his six (6) year old grandson who was deceased said hospital. The decedent was identified as C [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]), herein referred to as the decedent.
- B. Officers of the Stafford Police Department responded and learned the following information: The father of the decedent is Christopher Gregor (Date of Birth: [REDACTED]/1992, Social Security Number: [REDACTED], Address: [REDACTED] Barnegat, New Jersey 08005, Phone Number: [REDACTED]). The decedent primarily resides with his father.
- C. The mother of the decedent is Breanna Micciolo (Date of Birth: [REDACTED]/1996, Address: [REDACTED], Englishtown, New Jersey 07726, Phone number: [REDACTED]). Gregor and Breanna Micciolo share joint custody of the decedent.
- D. The decedent arrived at the hospital at approximately 1548 hours, and was reportedly experiencing symptoms of nausea and shortness of breath. His father, Christopher Gregor, transported the decedent to the hospital.
- E. Medical staff decided to conduct a CT scan. Upon arrival at CT scan, the decedent began having seizures. Medical staff attempted life saving measures. The decedent was pronounced deceased on April 2, 2021, at 1703 hours by Dr. Piccioti of Southern Ocean Medical Center.
- F. Medical staff informed the decedent's father, Christopher Gregor of the decedent's death, at which point, Gregor left the hospital in a four (4) door silver Honda sedan, bearing a Maryland registration number. Said registration number was unknown at the time.
- G. This Affiant was requested to respond to Southern Ocean Medical Center to assist with the death investigation.
- H. A review of the decedent's body yielded multiple bruises, including bruising to the chest, arms, and legs, as well as an abrasion to the right hip.
- I. Medical staff advised this Affiant that Gregor related to them that the decedent's mother, Breanna Micciolo, brought the decedent to Jersey Shore University Medical Center on April 1, 2021, due to bruising on the decedent's body. X-rays were conducted which yielded negative results for injury. Bloodwork of the decedent was also conducted which yielded levels in the normal range. Micciolo returned the victim home at approximately 0830 hours the following morning.
- J. Gregor further related to Medical staff that the decedent appeared lethargic and that he slept from approximately 0900 hours until 1500 hours. Upon waking up, the decedent had a loss of balance and vomited. Gregor subsequently brought the decedent to the hospital.
- K. Detective Joseph K. Mitchell, of this office, met with Southern Ocean Medical Center Director of Operations William Schreiber (DOB: [REDACTED])

- [REDACTED] 1976) to review security footage of Christopher Gregor's vehicle. Schreiber related that upon learning of his son's death, Gregor stated that he needed privacy and left the hospital. Schreiber followed Gregor outside, who left in a gray-silver Honda four (4) door sedan with a Maryland license plate, at approximately 1720 hours. A review of security footage yielded Gregor leaving in said vehicle.
- L. On April 2, 2021, Dr. Harry Larkin of the Ocean County Medical Examiner's Office responded to Southern Ocean Medical Center. Dr. Larkin reviewed the decedent's bloodwork results from the blood taken on April 1, 2021, at Jersey Shore University Medical Center, and the results of the decedent's blood taken upon admittance at Southern Ocean Medical Center on April 2, 2021. Dr. Larkin noted a large increase in the decedent's white blood cell, glucose, and lactic acid readings. Dr. Larkin advised that said readings were extremely high and could be indicative of sepsis or infection.
- M. Dr. Larkin subsequently ordered a CT scan of the decedent. Said CT scan yielded possible pneumonia in the lungs and a small abnormality in the rear of the decedent's brain.
- N. The decedent was processed and photographed by Detectives Chester and Walsh of the Ocean County Sheriff's Office, Crime Scene Investigations Unit. The decedent was placed in a body containment bag which was subsequently sealed at 2053 hours. The decedent was transported to Community Medical Center in Toms River where a postmortem examination was to be conducted.
- O. A search of police databases yielded Christopher Gregor's vehicle to be Maryland registration number [REDACTED]. Subsequently, Detective Joseph K. Mitchell contacted the New Jersey Regional Operations and Intelligence Center and requested an Automatic License Plate Recognition, Offline, and Vigilant search for Gregor's vehicle. Said requests yielded negative results.
- P. Gregor's parents, David Gregor and Carolyn Gregor, responded to Southern Ocean Medical Center. Gregor's parents were requested respond to Barnegat Township Police Department to conduct a formal interview.
- Q. Upon arrival at the Barnegat Township Police Department, this Affiant and Detective William Hetrick, of the Barnegat Township Police Department, conducted the taped statement of David and Carolyn Gregor. In short, the interview with David and Carolyn Gregor yielded the following: Christopher Gregor has been in the decedent's life for approximately two (2) years. There is an extensive history of custodial issues between Gregor and the decedent's mother, Breanna Micciolo. In addition, there have been numerous allegations of child abuse back and forth. Gregor's parents last spoke with him at approximately 1810 hours on April 2, 2021. Gregor advised them via text message that he wouldn't be back for a while and to take care of his dog.

- R. On April 2, 2021, Detective Joseph K. Mitchell contacted the decedent's New Jersey Division of Child Protection and Permanency case officer, Mark Waltonowski via telephone. Waltonowski related that there have been numerous complaints that the decedent was the victim of child abuse from both his mother and father. Waltonowski further related that he photographed and investigated bruising on the decedent on March 26, 2021. Waltonowski advised that the decedent related that said bruises were a result of running on the treadmill and playing football.
- S. Waltonowski related that further investigation yielded that the decedent was in the gym at the Atlantic Heights apartment complex located at [REDACTED] Barnegat, New Jersey 08005, with Christopher Gregor. Waltonowski advised that a review security footage from the gym yielded that on March 20, 2021, at approximately 1617 hours, the decedent and his father are observed entering the gym. The decedent is seen running on the treadmill and fell six (6) times. Waltonowski advised that Gregor is seen picking up the decedent and putting him back on the treadmill with the treadmill still moving, causing the decedent to fall. Waltonowski forwarded all of his reports, images, and documents related to the decedent for review.
- T. On April 2, 2021, this Affiant made application telephonically to the Court for a search warrant for the residence of Christopher Gregor at [REDACTED] Barnegat, New Jersey 08005. Said telephonic search warrant was approved by Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman, was authorized by the Honorable Steven F. Nemeth, J.S.C., at 2250 hours.
- U. In addition, this Affiant made application telephonically to the Court for a search warrant of the gray in color Honda sedan bearing Maryland registration number [REDACTED], registered to Christopher Gregor. The search warrant, which was approved by Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman, was authorized by the Honorable Steven F. Nemeth, J.S.C., at 2250 hours.
- V. This Affiant applied telephonically for a ping of telephone facility [REDACTED], belonging to Christopher Gregor. Said ping was authorized by the Honorable Steven Nemeth, J.S.C. at 2250 hours.
- W. A ping of Gregor's cell phone yielded a last known location near Longhorne, Pennsylvania at 1632 hours on April 2, 2021.
- X. Detective Joseph K. Mitchell and Detective Anthony Carrington of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Major Crime Unit, members of the Barnegat Township Police Department, and members of the Ocean County Sheriff's Office responded to Christopher Gregor's residence located at [REDACTED] Barnegat, New Jersey 08005, to execute a telephonic search warrant approved by the Honorable Steven Nemeth, J.S.C. on April 2, 2021, at 2250 hours.

- Y.** The time of entry for said search warrant was recorded as April 2, 2021, at 2323 hours. Said search warrant yielded the following: one (1) Apple iPhone and one (1) printed email. Said search warrant was left open, pending autopsy results. The residence was secured and an officer from the Barnegat Township Police Department remained on scene to secure the area. Also observed in the residence were multiple types of health and diet supplements.
- Z.** This Affiant and Detective Sergeant John Carroll responded to the Manalapan Police Department to conduct interviews of the decedent's mother Breanna Micciolo, and the decedent's grandmother, Rebecca Micciolo.
- AA.** On April 2, 2021, at approximately 2303 hours, this Affiant and Detective William Hetrick, of the Barnegat Township Police Department, conducted the taped statement of Breanna Micciolo. The statement, which was audio/video recorded, was conducted at the Manalapan Township Police Department.
- BB.** In short, Breanna Micciolo related the following:
- CC.** Christopher Gregor is the father of the decedent, however it was not until approximately two (2) years ago that the decedent met Gregor. Micciolo and Gregor share custody of the decedent although he spends the majority of the time with Gregor. Micciolo has suspected child abuse against the decedent by Gregor. Micciolo has made numerous referrals to DCP&P in reference to the same. Micciolo advised that the decedent has disclosed being hit by Gregor in the past.
- DD.** On April 1, 2021, Micciolo picked the decedent up at approximately 1630 hours at the Barnegat Township Police Department. Micciolo brought the decedent to the pediatrician for a scheduled appointment at 1730 hours. The decedent advised the pediatrician of an incident that occurred involving a treadmill. Micciolo stated that this happened as a result of Micciolo dropping the decedent off at Gregor's later than anticipated. The decedent told Micciolo that Gregor made him run on the treadmill really fast because Gregor was mad. While running on the treadmill the decedent fell and hit his head.
- EE.** At approximately 2311 hours, this Affiant and Detective Hetrick were advised by Detective Sergeant John Carroll that Micciolo's mother retained an attorney on her behalf.
- FF.** At approximately 2317 hours, Micciolo advised that she wanted to continue to speak with us without an attorney present.
- GG.** In addition to the aforementioned, Micciolo related the following:
- HH.** The pediatrician advised Micciolo that she believes the bruising to the decedent's body is suspicious. Micciolo described numerous bruises on the decedent's body. A bruise on the decedent's chest was the result of Gregor throwing a football to him.
- II.** Micciolo subsequently brought the decedent to Community Medical Center at the advice of the pediatrician. Micciolo was advised that she should bring the decedent to Jersey Shore University Medical Center (JSUMC), which she did. While at JSUMC, x-rays and bloodwork were conducted. The x-rays yielded negative results for injury and the bloodwork yielded levels within normal range.

STATE V. CHRISTOPHER GREGOR
APPENDIX A - AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

- JJ.** At approximately 0130, hours on April 2, 2021, Micciolo brought the decedent back to her residence after not being able to get in touch with Gregor. At approximately 0800 hours, the decedent ate part of a bagel and a yogurt for breakfast. Micciolo dropped the decedent off at Gregor's at approximately 0900 hours. Micciolo described the decedent's demeanor as normal when she left him at Gregor's residence.
- KK.** Gregor was angry with Micciolo for taking the decedent to the doctor and calling DCP&P. Gregor was also angry that Micciolo kept the decedent overnight. During an argument between Micciolo and Gregor, Micciolo told Gregor that the decedent told the doctor about the treadmill.
- LL.** Micciolo last heard from Gregor at approximately 1530 hours, when Gregor was taking the decedent to the hospital.
- MM.** The decedent has advised Micciolo of numerous injuries that were caused by Gregor. Micciolo stated the decedent would rarely get injured prior to Gregor coming into the decedent's life. Micciolo has called DCP&P numerous times to report the injuries.
- NN.** Breanna Micciolo was advised that we would like to search her cell phone for evidence, to which she agreed. This Affiant read Micciolo the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Consent to Search Digital Evidence form. Micciolo acknowledged she understood and subsequently signed same granting consent to have her cell phone extracted. Micciolo's cell phone was turned over to the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office High Tech Crime Unit for extraction.
- OO.** This Affiant and Detective Hetrick subsequently conducted the statement of Rebecca Micciolo. The statement, which took place at the Manalapan Police Department, was audio and video recorded. In short, Rebecca Micciolo related the following.
- PP.** Christopher Gregor is the father of the decedent. Gregor has been abusing the decedent since he came into his life. The decedent was conceived as a result of a sexual assault on Breanna Micciolo by Gregor. Gregor was not in the child's life until approximately two (2) years ago. There have been numerous DCP&P referrals alleging child abuse of the decedent by Gregor. The decedent has disclosed to family members in the past that he has been hit by Gregor.
- QQ.** On one of Gregor's visits with the decedent, Gregor requested the decedent spend the night, to which Rebecca Micciolo declined. The decedent spent the night at the Gregor residence against Rebecca Micciolo's will. The decedent returned the following morning with a blood on his shirt and mouth. Upon being asked what happened, the decedent stated that he didn't want to talk about it and that it was bad. DCP&P ultimately got involved and found that Gregor went to kick a football and the decedent's face got in the way. The decedent later told a family member that he said a bad word and Gregor subsequently hit him in the face.

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- RR.** On a separate occasion, Breanna Micciolo picked the decedent up from school and noticed injuries to the decedent's face. When questioned, the decedent advised that Gregor made him run on the treadmill because he is fat. Gregor made the child lose weight because he believed the decedent was fat. Gregor frequently weighed the decedent and would make him work out to lose weight.
- SS.** Rebecca Micciolo believed that the decedent would not disclose the abuse to anyone because he was afraid of Gregor. The decedent expressed that no one can help him when being asked about numerous bruises. As a result of the bruising, an appointment was made for the decedent to see a pediatrician. The decedent was ultimately brought to Jersey Shore University Medical Center by Breanna Micciolo. Rebecca Micciolo subsequently went to the hospital to drop off a phone charger. She urged the decedent to tell medical staff what was being done so they can help him.
- TT.** Breanna Micciolo returned home with the decedent at approximately 0130 hours. In the morning, at approximately 0800 hours the decedent had part of a bagel with cream cheese and a yogurt drink. Breanna Micciolo then brought the decedent to Gregor's residence. A while later, Breanna Micciolo was contacted by Gregor and told that the decedent was not waking up, had leg pain and was vomiting and that Gregor was bringing the decedent to the hospital.
- UU.** Rebecca Micciolo related that the decedent was acting normal prior to being brought back to Gregor's. She further advised that the decedent was not complaining of pain and was walking around.
- VV.** This Affiant subsequently read Rebecca Micciolo the Manalapan Township Police Department's Consent to Search Form. Micciolo indicated she understood said form and signed the same granting consent to have her residence at [REDACTED] in Englishtown searched.
- WW.** Detectives subsequently responded to [REDACTED] in Englishtown to execute the search. Said search yielded negative results for evidence in furtherance of this investigation.
- XX.** On Saturday, April 3, 2021, at approximately 0123 hours, this Affiant and Detective Hetrick conducted the statement of Dustin Vorndran. The statement, which was conducted outside of [REDACTED] during the consent search, was memorialized via my county issued digital recorder.
- YY.** In short, Vorndran related the following:
- ZZ.** Vorndran has been dating Breanna Micciolo for several years. Micciolo was a good mother to the decedent, although she failed to discipline the decedent at times. The decedent changed once his father started to become of the picture. Vorndran further stated that he has never seen physical abuse against the decedent, specifically by Breanna and Rebecca Micciolo.
- AAA.** On Saturday, April 3, 2021, at approximately 0133 hours, this Affiant and Detective Hetrick conducted the taped statement of Richard

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Palumbo. The statement, which was conducted at [REDACTED] during the consent search, was memorialized via my county issued digital recorder.

BBB. In short, Palumbo related the following:

CCC. Palumbo has been with the Micciolo family for approximately three (3) and a half years. Palumbo rarely saw the decedent, he would try not to be around when the decedent was at the Micciolo's house. Prior to Gregor being in the decedent's life, Palumbo described the decedent as normal for his age. Palumbo described Breanna and Rebecca Micciolo as a good mom and good grandmother, respectively.

DDD. The decedent has told Palumbo in the past that he would get hit by Gregor. Palumbo has never seen Breanna nor Rebecca hit the decedent. The decedent would get all of his bruises while under the care of Gregor and/or Gregor's parents. The decedent would have bruising every time he returned from the care of Gregor.

EEE. Micciolo and the decedent returned home from the hospital at approximately 0130 hours on the day of his death. In the morning, at approximately 0815 hours, the decedent was in the kitchen eating a half of a bagel and juice. The decedent was acting normal at that time.

FFF. Palumbo stated that the decedent didn't talk about being hurt by his father because he believed that if the decedent told anyone he would get beaten. Palumbo further stated that this time he talked. Palumbo referenced a writing outside the residence, written by the decedent that read "I'm dead".

GGG. Detectives reviewed the documents sent by New Jersey Division of Child Protection and Permanency Office Mark Waltonowski. Said documents yielded that the decedent was brought to Community Medical Center in Toms River on April 1, 2021 by his mother, Breanna Micciolo. Medical Staff advised Micciolo that her son should be brought to Jersey Shore University Medical Center for further evaluation, and recommended that Medial Staff transport him there. Medical Staff further advised Micciolo that it was not recommended that the decedent leave the hospital, due to the risk of sepsis. Breanna Micciolo subsequently left and responded to Jersey Shore University Medical Center with her son. X-rays of the decedent were conducted, and yielded negative results for injury.

HHH. Further review of said documents yielded that the decedent revealed that his father, Christopher Gregor, would punish him by making him run fast on the treadmill.

III. On Saturday, April 3, 2021, at approximately 0900 hours, a postmortem examination was conducted on the body of the decedent. The examination, which took place at Community Medical Center, was conducted by Dr. Dante Ragasa of the Ocean County Medical Examiner's Office. Dr. Ragasa noted several bruises to the decedent, as well as hemorrhaging of the liver. In addition, Dr. Ragasa noted several injuries which he stated could be attributed to live saving measures. Dr. Ragasa reviewed the decedent's prior bloodwork from

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Jersey Shore University Medical Center on April 1, 2021, and Southern Ocean Medical Center on April 2, 2021. Dr. Ragasa noted the decedent's blood levels from Southern Ocean Medical Center on April 2, 2021, to be abnormal and require further studies. Dr. Ragasa determined the cause and manner of death to be pending toxicology and further investigation.

JJJ. Following the postmortem examination, detectives responded to the residence of Christopher Gregor at [REDACTED] in Barnegat Township, for the continued execution of the aforementioned search warrant. A search of the residence resulted in the collection of numerous workout supplements and multiple electronic devices. Also collected was the vomit covered clothing of the decedent from the garbage can in the kitchen.

KKK. On Saturday, April 3, 2021, this Affiant was provided video surveillance from the fitness center located at Atlantic Heights at [REDACTED] in Barnegat, New Jersey. A review of the video provided yielded the following:

LLL. On Saturday, March 20, 2021, at approximately 1617 hours, the decedent and Gregor enter the fitness center. Gregor points the decedent toward the area of the treadmills. At approximately 1618 hours, the decedent begins running on a treadmill. At approximately 1627 hours, Gregor approached the treadmill and appears to increase the speed. At approximately 1628 hours, the decedent falls off of the back of the treadmill. Gregor subsequently picks the decedent up by grabbing his shirt, putting him back on the moving treadmill. The decedent appears to struggle to gain footing, while Gregor appears to be biting on the top of the decedent's head. The decedent regains footing and continues running on the treadmill. Gregor appears to again adjust the speed of the treadmill as the decedent again falls off of the back. The decedent attempts to run onto the moving treadmill four (4) additional times, falling off of the back each time, while Gregor stands next to the treadmill. Gregor then appears to instruct the decedent to step on the side of the treadmill and attempt to get on the moving treadmill. At approximately 1629 hours, the decedent gets back on the treadmill and continues running. At approximately 1629 hours, the treadmill is turned off and the decedent steps off of the back. At approximately 1630 hours, the decedent and Gregor exit the gym.

MMM. On Saturday April 3, 2021, at approximately 1637 hours, this Affiant spoke with Courtney Markland in reference to her knowledge of the decedent and his father, Christopher Gregor. The conversation, which occurred via phone on my county issued cell phone, was audio recorded. In short, Markland advised that she met Gregor on a dating app approximately one (1) week ago. Markland traveled from her residence in Quakertown, Pennsylvania, to meet Gregor at his residence

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in Barnegat on April 1, 2021. Markland added that she was pulled over by a Barnegat Police Officer on her way to his residence. Markland further advised that she spent the night with Gregor and left at approximately 0600 hours on April 2, 2021. Markland related that she and Gregor talked throughout the day on April 2, 2021. Between the hours of 1200 and 1400, Gregor related that the decedent was home and acting quiet, laying in his bedroom. Gregor further related to Markland that the decedent said he did not want to see his mom anymore. Since that time, Markland made attempts to contact Gregor as recently as April 3, 2021, but was met with negative results.

NNN. At approximately 1659 hours, this Affiant was notified that the cellular device of Gregor was pinging in the area of Little Rock, Arkansas.

OOO. At approximately 1726 hours, this Affiant spoke with Christopher Gregor. The conversation, which occurred via phone on my county issued cell phone, was audio recorded. In short, Gregor apologized for turning his phone off after the death of his son. Gregor advised that he retained an attorney after seeing Facebook postings by Micciolo calling him a murderer.

PPP. A short while later, this Affiant was advised that Gregor's attorney, Mario Galluci [REDACTED], contacted the Barnegat Township Police Department wishing to speak with detectives regarding the decedent.

QQQ. At approximately 1834 hours, this Affiant was contacted by Courtney Markland. Markland advised that she was able to see Gregor's location via SnapChat. Markland further advised that Gregor appeared to travel to Hicks Station, Arkansas, approximately one (1) hour prior.

RRR. On Sunday, April 4, 2021, this Affiant was notified that Christopher Gregor was stopped in his vehicle by Officer Cook of the Alcoa Police Department in Alcoa, Tennessee. The vehicle was subsequently secured by the Alcoa Police Department pending transfer to the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office. This Affiant was further advised that in the vehicle with Gregor was Laura G. Powell, of Long Branch. Located inside said vehicle was a white in color Apple iPhone with a black translucent case covering the back and sides and a black in color Apple iPhone with a clear and black case covering the back and sides. In addition, this Affiant was advised by Detective Jeff Parsons of the Alcoa Police Department that Powell stated her and Gregor texted about the death of Gregor's son.

SSS. On Monday, April 5, 2021, this Affiant, Detective Jim Purcell, of the Barnegat Township Police Department, and Detective Justin Vandergriff, of the Alcoa (TN) Police Department, appeared in front of the Honorable Tammy Harrington, Circuit Court Judge, to make application for a search warrant for the vehicle of Christopher

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Gregor. The Honorable Harrington subsequently authorized said warrant.

TTT. On Tuesday, April 6, 2021, the aforementioned search warrant was executed with the assistance of the Ocean County Sheriff's Office, Crime Scene Investigations, and the Alcoa Police Department. A search of the vehicle yielded the collection of two (2) Apple iPhones (previously collected and put into airplane mode), one (1) black in color LG L355DL cell phone, two (2) thumb drives, one white in color Yuneec Breeze Flying Camera, a baseball bat, a track baton, and one (1) bottle of Niacin.

UUU. This Affiant and Detective Vandergriff responded to the Marriott in Alcoa where Gregor advised he was staying, in an attempt to make contact with the female, Laura Powell. Detectives were advised that Gregor checked out of the hotel on April 5. Detectives then responded to Enterprise, which is located immediately in front of the Marriott. It was learned that Gregor rented a vehicle on April 5. A subpoena was subsequently issued for vehicle information.

VVV. This Affiant was provided photos of the abovementioned thumb drives seized from the vehicle of Christopher Gregor. Said devices can be described as one (1) white in color USB thumb drive with "giovatto ADVERTISING" written in black on the white in color plastic casing on one side and "givatto.com" written in black on the other side and one (1) black in color USB thumb drive with an "S" written in red ink on one side of the white plastic casing.

WWW. All collected electronic devices were subsequently turned over to the High Tech Crime Squad for extraction pursuant to Court authorized search warrants. This Affiant was subsequently provided a copy of the extractions of said devices from the High Tech Crime Squad.

XXX. Additionally, all collected electronics from the apartment of Christopher Gregor at [REDACTED], [REDACTED] were turned over to the High Tech Crime Squad for extraction pursuant to Court authorized search warrants. This Affiant was subsequently provided a copy of the extractions of said devices from the High Tech Crime Squad.

YYY. This Affiant was provided with a copy of the cell phone extraction of an Apple iPhone 11 with an associated Apple ID of [REDACTED] and an associated telephone facility [REDACTED], identified as that of Christopher Gregor. A look up of said telephone facility number utilizing an online law enforcement database yielded that said telephone facility is serviced by Verizon Wireless.

ZZZ. A review of Christopher Gregor's cellphone yielded the following searched items. On March 25, 2021 at approximately 2136 hours, a web search is conducted for "Will red marks turn into bruises". On April 2, 2021, at approximately 1809 hours, a web search is conducted for "can your phone be tracked in airplane mode". At approximately 1810

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hours, a web search is conducted for "can my car be tracked". On April 3, 2021 at approximately 1514 hours a web search is conducted for "What causes a rise in blood sugar in white blood cells". At approximately 1555 hours, a web search is conducted for "could internal bleeding raise your blood sugar levels". At approximately 2122 hours, a web search is conducted for "Ashley Kelly chris gregor restraining order". On April 4, 2021 at approximately 0958 hours, a web search is conducted for "there was a murder determined from an autopsy how long to file charges". At approximately 1021 hours, a web search is conducted for "how long after an autopsy to file charges get filed".

AAAA. A review of the call log of Gregor's cellphone yielded the following. Six (6) connected calls between Gregor and an individual with the contact name "Mom" utilizing telephone facility [REDACTED] on April 2, 2021 from approximately 1510 hours to 1712 hours. A look up of said telephone facility utilizing an online law enforcement database yielded that said facility is serviced by Verizon Wireless.

BBBB. Two (2) connected calls between Gregor and an individual with the contact name "Dad" utilizing telephone facility [REDACTED] on April 2, 2021 from approximately 1720 hours to 1722 hours. Five (5) connected calls between Gregor and his father from April 3, 2021 at approximately 1419 hours to April 4, 2021 at approximately 0932 hours. A look up of said telephone facility utilizing an online law enforcement database yielded that said facility is serviced by Verizon Wireless.

CCCC. A review of the messages on Gregor's phone yielded the following.

DDDD. On April 2, 2021, at approximately 0836 hours, Gregor advises an individual utilizing telephone facility [REDACTED] that "She just dropped him off". At approximately 1259 hours, Gregor states, in reference to C [REDACTED], "But I'm sure he is going to pass out probably within the next couple hours he might wake up around midnight or 1 AM". At approximately 1410 hours, Gregor states, "I'm actually really concerned because he has been sleeping basically this entire time". At approximately 1644 hours, Gregor writes "Hey, something is going on with my son and I had to bring him to the hospital".

EEEE. On April 2, 2021, Gregor has a conversation with individual with the contact name "Amiee" and utilizing telephone facility [REDACTED]. At approximately 0953 hours Gregor states, "He's home, but I still applied for an emergent application to remove any visitation moving forward". At approximately 0954 hours "Amiee" writes, "He's ok though, right?" Gregor replies, "Yeahhh". On April 3, 2021, at approximately 1714 hours, Gregor states, "Trust me I am too, just let me know because I'm compiling a list of statements now to send to my attorney. Although they're not looking at me as a suspect yes it's

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all topsy comes back with anything that may be related to a homicide it's going to point the finger directly at her family".

FFFF. On April 3, 2021, Gregor has a conversation with an individual with the contact name of "Sara Cervezza" utilizing telephone facility [REDACTED] in reference to the death of his son. At approximately 1743 hours, Gregor states "Yeah I'm not doing great... idk he came home at 9am or so slept til 3 when I realized something was really wrong he couldn't speak or stand".

GGGG. On April 3, 2021, at approximately 1815 hours, Gregor sends what appears to be a screenshot of his Instagram story to an individual that identifies himself as "Brandon Hyman", utilizing telephone facility [REDACTED]. The screenshot is white text over a blue background. The text reads, "Thank you to everyone that has sent condolences, I'm just in the process of grieving. It disgusts me that people throw random wild allegations out there instead of grieving first. I am not "wanted" and no charges have been filed. Looks like he had a GI slow bleed not sure if it's Bc he was potentially anemic or something else. It's pathetic that I feel the need to explain this but there's a reason why when I found out I had a son that I thought for custody and won full custody over an ex herion and meth addict".

HHHH. On April 3, 2021, Gregor engages in an Instagram chat with an individual with account [REDACTED]. At approximately 1853 hours, Gregor writes, "Crazy since that's exactly what the doc said but thanks for the condolences. See you haven't changed". At approximately 1854 hours, the other party responds, "Chris you don't even know me so stop. I'm a nurse. I deal with Gi bleeds all day everyday. I'm letting you know this post looks bad. If you wanna prove yourself the. You take the picture of the summary that it was a GI bleed. Until then stop posting." At approximately 1854 hours, Gregor writes, "I'd rather listen to the doctor than a cunt nurse".

IIII. On April 3, 2021, at approximately 2100 hours, Gregor tells an individual with the contact name "Andre Dowdy Jr." via Instagram messenger, "My son had internal bleeding and passed yesterday".

JJJJ. On April 4, 2021, at approximately 1217 hours, Gregor tells an individual with the contact name "Rachel" in a Tinder message that he was going to see his brother in "LA".

KKKK. This Affiant was provided a copy of the extraction of the cellular device belonging to Breanna Micciolo pursuant to the aforementioned consent to search granted by the same.

LLLL. A review of the call log yielded approximately sixteen (16) calls between Micciolo and telephone facility [REDACTED] with a contact name of "Chris" on April 2, 2021. Said telephone facility has been identified as being utilized by Christopher Gregor. At approximately 1524 hours, there is a missed call from Gregor. At approximately

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1525 hours, there is an outgoing call to Gregor that is connected for one (1) minute and seven (7) seconds. Six (6) additional calls connect between approximately 1659 hours and 1939 hours with approximate durations between one (1) and two (2) seconds.

MMM. A review of the messages yielded the following:

NNNN. On April 1, 2021, an MMS conversation takes place between Micciolo and telephone facility [REDACTED] with the contact name "Mom". Said telephone facility was previously identified as being utilized by Rebecca Micciolo. The conversation, which commences at approximately 1508 hours, is in reference to an order being drafted by a judge. At approximately 1623 hours, Micciolo advises that the order was denied. At approximately 1659 hours, Rebecca Micciolo states that Micciolo can go to the doctor's office at 1715 hours. At approximately 1732 hours, Rebecca Micciolo tells Micciolo to beg the doctor to help the decedent. On April 2, 2021, at approximately 0048 hours, Micciolo states that she is coming home.

OOOO. On April 1, 2021, Micciolo has a Facebook Messenger conversation with an individual utilizing Facebook profile ID [REDACTED] and a display name of "Rebecca Loudin". This Affiant knows said individual to be Rebecca Micciolo. The conversation, which commences at approximately 1708 hours, is in reference to Micciolo bringing the decedent to the doctor and then the hospital. At approximately 2055 hours, Rebecca Micciolo asks if the decedent is okay, to which Micciolo replies "Yes".

PPPP. An SMS conversation between Gregor and Micciolo commences on April 1, 2021, in which Micciolo confirms picking up C.M. at 1630 hours. They agree that she will pick C [REDACTED] up from the police station.

QOOO. Another conversation between the two commences at approximately 1926 hours. Gregor inquires asks where Micciolo is. Micciolo advises that she is on her way to Jersey Shore Medical Center. At approximately 2052 hours, Micciolo states that she is at the hospital and invites Gregor to come. Gregor indicates that he is going to the Barnegat police station to file a report. At approximately 0048 hours, Micciolo offers to drop C.M. off and gets no reply.

RRRR. On April 2, 2021, at approximately 0646 hours a conversation between Gregor and Micciolo commences. At approximately 0834 hours, Gregor tell Micciolo to drop the decedent off at his house. At approximately 0902 hours, Micciolo asks Gregor where he is. Gregor responds that he is home and to have the decedent walk in the house. At approximately 0958, Micciolo states, "And you know what if they find out that you did cause any of those bruises not only will you have him taken from you you will be charged with child abuse says the prosecutor I spoke to". To which Gregor denies. At approximately 1005 hours, Micciolo states "Now keep your hands off my kid and have a great weekend". At approximately 1139 hours, Micciolo states, "I'm

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going to be an adult for a second and explain something to you. When your kid has a huge bruise on his forehead with no explanation from the other parent, which made me suspicious in the first place, then you Skype and he has a huge red mark on his face saying he got it during football, then he comes over and has huge bruises on every part of his body with no explanation except football? Tell me what you would do? I wouldn't have gone this far if it was one accident or two maybe but now three? If it was the other way around you would have done the same. If you think I want to put C [REDACTED], myself, or anyone else involved through this just to do it you're crazy. I care about C [REDACTED] more than anyone has or will and I hope you aren't doing anything to him and if I'm proven wrong then I will be the first to apologize but right now I have every right to believe it could be true. Call me whatever you want but I'm just trying to protect him." The conversation ends at approximately 1155 hours.

SSSS. Another conversation between Gregor and Micciolo commences at approximately 1522 hours. Gregor asks Micciolo to provide the results from the night prior. At approximately 1525 hours, Gregor advises Micciolo that he is bringing the decedent to the hospital. Micciolo responds multiple times with no response from Gregor. At approximately 1802 hours, Micciolo advises Gregor that the police are looking for him. The last message is sent by Micciolo at approximately 1919 hours with no response.

TTTT. On April 1, 2021, Micciolo has a conversation throughout the day and into the early morning hours of April 2, 2021, via Facebook messenger with Facebook profile ID [REDACTED] and a display name of "Dustin Vorndran". At approximately 1642 hours, Vorndran states, "...So what the hell happened to today's doctor visit?? And when you say "evaluate him" I hope you don't mean "c [REDACTED] version of what's going on" it would be nice if you couldve still went to get C [REDACTED] today and just had at least an hour of alone time with him to explain to him "this is it... If you tell these people without your dad around what's going on, you won't have to go back C [REDACTED]" because that's what he needs to hear..." At approximately 2050 hours, Micciolo advises that she is at the hospital. At approximately 0049 hours, Micciolo advises that she is leaving the hospital. At approximately 0147 hours, Micciolo states that she and the decedent need to go to sleep and that everything is "fine". At approximately 0149 hours, Micciolo says, "He told them about the treadmill".

UUUU. A review of the videos contained within the extraction yielded the following:

VVVV. Said review yielded a video from January 30, 2021, at approximately 1658 hours with a file name "20210130_165632.mp4". In the video, which is two (2) minutes and twelve (12) seconds in length, the camera appears to be placed down. There is a conversation between a female,

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known by her voice by this Affiant as Breanna Micciolo, speaking with a young male child that she identifies as "C[REDACTED]". The decedent describes being choked by his dad and describes having his hair pulled. In reference to being choked by his dad, the decedent states "I can't breathe". Micciolo asks the decedent how he received the other bruising on his stomach and his back, to which the decedent replies, "I think that's him". Micciolo asks the decedent if he is lying about saying his dad hurt him to which he replies "Nope".

WWW. Additionally, said review yielded a video from April 2, 2021, at approximately 0902 hours, with the file name "20210402_090215.mp4". In the video, which is thirty-three (33) seconds in length, the camera appears to be placed down. There is a conversation between a female, known by her voice by this Affiant as Breanna Micciolo, speaking with a young male child, believe to be the decedent. The conversation is in reference to Micciolo giving the decedent a paper pertaining to the doctor's visit. Micciolo advises the decedent that she's not sure where "he", Gregor is. The decedent replies "Are you gonna call him?" Micciolo states that he is inside, despite his car not being there. It should be noted that the decedent's speech is clear and not slurred.

XXXX. A review of the images contained within the extraction yielded the following:

YYYY. A photo dated March 23, 2021, with a timestamp of 2328 hours, and a file name of "20201018_162246.jpg". Said photo appears to be of the arm of the decedent. There is apparent bruising on the forearm.

ZZZZ. A photo dated March 23, 2021, with a timestamp of 2328 hours, and a filename of "20201106_202853.jpg". Said photo appears to be of the torso of the decedent. There is apparent bruising to the chest and shoulder.

AAAA. A photo dated March 28, 2021, with a timestamp of 1840 hours, and a file name of "1616971223061.jpg". Said photo is of the decedent. There is apparent bruising to the decedent's forehead.

BBBB. A photo dated March 28, 2021, with a timestamp of 1840 hours, and a file name of "1616971221911.jpg". Said photo is of what appears to be the decedent. There is apparent bruising and an abrasion to the decedent's side.

CCCC. A photo dated March 28, 2021, with a timestamp of 1849 hours, and a file name of "1616971774037.jpg". Said photo is of the decedent sitting at a table without a shirt on. There is apparent bruising to the decedent's hip and what appears to be an abrasion over the left eye.

DDDD. A photo dated March 31, 2021, with a timestamp of 1024 hours, and a file name of "20201212_074005.jpg". Said photo is of the decedent. There is apparent blood pooling in the eye.

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EEEEEE. A photo dated March 31, 2021, with a timestamp of 1025 hours, and a file name of "20201120_202201.jpg". Said photo is of what appears to be the decedent without a shirt on. There is apparent bruising visible on the decedent's chest.

FFFFF. A photo dated March 31, 2021, with a timestamp of 1022 hours, and a file name of "20201212_075724.jpg". Said photo is of the decedent and depicts apparent bruising to the forehead.

GGGGG. There are numerous additional images depicting various injuries to the decedent.

HHHHH. A review of the search history of the device yielded the following: On January 26, 2021, there are numerous searches in reference to what to do if you suspect someone is being abused. On March 29, 2021, there were numerous searches pertaining to taking a child to the doctor with suspicious bruising. Additionally on March 29, 2021, there were numerous searches in reference to a child not disclosing abuse to DCP&P. On March 30, 2021, a search was conducted for "non custodial parent concerned about child abuse". Numerous searches in reference to custody and child abuse on March 31, 2021 were conducted.

IIIIII. On June 8, 2021, at approximately 1358 hours, this Affiant and Detective Hetrick conducted the taped statement of Laura Powell. The statement, which took place at the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Major Crime Unit, was audio and video recorded.

JJJJJ. In short, Powell related the following:

KKKKK. Powell has been in an off and on dating relationship with Gregor for the past two years. Powell spoke with Gregor the day after [REDACTED] died. Gregor told Powell that he was in Tennessee. Powell offered to fly down to Tennessee and drive back to New Jersey with Gregor.

LLLLL. In relation to the decedent, Gregor advised Powell that the decedent's mother, Breanna Micciolo, dropped the decedent off at Gregor's on the morning of his death. Gregor related to Powell that the decedent seemed as if something was off. The decedent took a nap. Upon waking from the nap, Gregor brought the decedent to the hospital.

MMMMM. Gregor told Powell that he believed Micciolo's family may have done something to the decedent and that it was likely an accident.

NNNNN. Powell has never seen any physical abuse of the decedent by Gregor.

OOOOO. On Tuesday, June 29, 2021, at approximately 1351 hours, this Affiant spoke with Dr. Nancy Deacon of Ivy Pediatrics in reference to the decedent's April 1 doctors visit. Dr. Deacon advised that she observed large bruising to the decedent. Dr. Deacon further related that the decedent seemed scared and reported that his father makes him run on the treadmill because he is fat.

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PPPPP. On Tuesday, June 29, 2021, this Affiant requested all reports made pertaining to the decedent to the Division of Child Permanency and Protection (DCP&P). On Tuesday, July 6, 2021, this Affiant received said records.

QQQQQ. A review of the records yielded fourteen (14) reports. Seven (7) of said reports listed Christopher Gregor as the alleged perpetrator. One (1) report listed Gino Micciolo as the alleged perpetrator. One (1) report listed Breanna Micciolo as the alleged perpetrator. Three (3) reports listed Rebecca Micciolo as the alleged perpetrator. One (1) report listed the alleged perpetrator as unknown. One (1) report was the result of a requested welfare check.

RRRRR. On Monday, July 19, 2021, at approximately 1714 hours, this Affiant and Detective Hetrick conducted the taped statement of Rebeccamae Bowers. The statement, which took place at the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Major Crime Unit, was audio and video recorded.

SSSSS. In short Bowers related the following:

TTTTT. Bowers met Gregor on a dating website in April of 2020. Bowers ended things when she noticed some "red flags". Bowers observed an incident while crabbing that Gregor got angry at the decedent and threw him off of a boat. That same day, prior to crabbing, Bowers noticed Gregor hiding drinking alcohol on the way to go crabbing. Gregor said he was just "rough housing" with the decedent.

UUUUU. Bowers advised that Gregor was quick to "flip" when something did not go his way.

VVVVV. The day prior to the decedent's death, Gregor told Bowers that Micciolo was holding the decedent hostage. Following the decedent's death Bowers spoke with Gregor on the phone. Gregor told Bowers that the decedent was brought home by Micciolo and the decedent was tired and went right to sleep. When the decedent woke up, Gregor brought him to the hospital where the decedent died in his arms. Gregor believed that the decedent was drugged by Micciolo.

WWWWW. Gregor further asked Bowers to write a letter on his behalf stating that Gregor was good with the decedent and her children.

XXXXX. Following the taped statement of Bowers, Bowers agreed to attempt a consensual intercept between her and Gregor. The consensual intercept, which was authorized by Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman at 1749 hours, was met with negative results.

YYYYY. On Monday, September 20, 2021 this Affiant, Chief Trial Attorney Weatherstone and Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Pressman spoke with Dr. Thomas Andrew of White Mountain Forensic. This Affiant briefed Dr. Andrew on the facts of the case. Dr. Andrew advised he would be willing to review the case.

ZZZZZ. On Friday, February 11, 2022, at approximately 1200 hours, this Affiant and Detective Hetrick conducted the taped statement of Aimee Dennis. The statement, which took place at the Ocean County

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Prosecutor's Office Major Crime Unit, was audio and video recorded. It should be noted that Dennis brought a notebook with her, detailing conversations between her and Gregor. The notebook was subsequently placed into evidence.

AAAAAA. In short, Dennis related the following:

BBBBBB. Dennis met Gregor through an online dating application. Dennis dated Gregor from about July 2020 to about December 2020. Dennis never saw anything "off" between Gregor and the decedent. Dennis did, however, observe bruising to the decedent. Gregor told Dennis that the decedent bruised easily because he was anemic.

CCCCCC. On April 1, 2021, Gregor told Dennis that Micciolo did not bring the decedent home and as a result he planned to go to Court in the morning.

DDDDDD. On April 2, 2021, Gregor told Dennis that the decedent was home. Dennis asked if the decedent was okay to which he said "yeah".

EEEEEE. On April 3, 2021, Gregor called Dennis and told her that his son passed away. Gregor told Dennis that when the decedent was dropped off at his residence he was tired. The decedent took a nap and upon waking up was stumbling, slurring his words and loopy. Gregor then took the decedent to the hospital. Gregor related that he was in Arkansas and that he left the area so he would not confront Micciolo's family. Gregor told Dennis that he is going to get charged with murder as a result of posts on Facebook. Gregor stated that he believed that Micciolo's family hurt the decedent. Gregor further advised that he did not believe that they hurt the decedent on purpose but it was something that may have went too far.

FFFFFF. Dennis spoke with Gregor prior to being charged with Endangering the Welfare of a child in reference to the treadmill video. Gregor told Dennis that the decedent needed to lose weight and referred to him as the "Michelin Man".

GGGGGG. Gregor further related that he was worried his father would have a heart attack if he is found guilty of killing the decedent.

HHHHHH. Following the taped statement of Dennis, Dennis agreed to conduct a consensual intercept, in the form of recorded phone calls, between her and Gregor. The consensual intercept, which was authorized for a period of twenty (20) days, was authorized by Chief Trial Attorney Michael Weatherstone on Thursday, February 10, 2022 at 1330 hours.

IIIIII. On Friday, February 11, 2022, at approximately 1306 hours, Dennis placed a phone call to Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

JJJJJJ. In short, Gregor related the following:

KKKKKK. The decedent died from sepsis and a heart contusion, and that the contusion was likely a result of CPR. Gregor has not been advised of the toxicology results of the decedent. Gregor described the

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decedent as a "drunk little kid" when he returned home. Gregor further stated the decedent was tired and took a nap. Gregor believes the case isn't closed because it can't be determined when the contusion took place.

LLLLLL. Gregor advised that he is staying with his parents "on and off". Gregor also advised that he sometimes stays with a friend.

MMMMMM. Gregor further stated that he hopes it was just a freak accident.

NNNNNN. On Friday, February 11, 2022, at approximately 1612 hours, Dennis placed a phone call to Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

OOOOOO. Said phone call was met with negative results.

PPPPPP. On Friday, February 11, 2022, at approximately 1626 hours, Dennis received a phone call from Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

QQQQQQ. In short, Gregor related the following:

RRRRRR. Gregor related that it is still a waiting game at this point.

SSSSSS. On Tuesday, February 15, 2022, at approximately 1411 hours, Dennis placed a phone call to Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

TTTTTT. In short, Gregor related the following:

UUUUUU. Gregor is going to invite "Bre" to his wedding. This Affiant knows "Bre" is short for Breanna Micciolo. Micciolo posted videos of the decedent on social media and claims that Gregor was abusive to the decedent. Gregor further related that Micciolo accused Gregor of killing the decedent.

VVVVVV. Gregor advised that there is probably something in the decedent's toxicology and that is why the report has not been released.

WWWWWW. On Tuesday, February 15, 2022, at approximately 1600 hours, Dennis received a phone call from Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

XXXXXX. In short, Gregor related the following:

YYYYYY. Gregor was on his way home from work to his girlfriend's house. A lot of people that look at Micciolo's Facebook page would think that Gregor's not a good person.

ZZZZZZ. There were four (4) people with the decedent the morning before his death that were not supposed to be around him.

AAAAAA. Gregor has no one other than Peyton that can vouch for him from the day of the decedent's death. There was a female over Gregor's apartment the night prior but left prior to the decedent coming home. This Affiant knows Peyton to be Gregor's dog. Gregor further stated that he lives on a second floor apartment and that if there was any "ass whooping" going on, someone would have heard it and he would have been arrested.

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BBBBBBB. Micciolo brought the decedent to the hospital the night prior to his death. Gregor stated that if Micciolo was concerned about the decedent's well-being, she should not have dropped him back off in the morning.

CCCCCCC. Gregor wants to have another kid.

DDDDDDD. Gregor stated that it is unlikely that he will get charged with murder. He believes that Micciolo may have left drugs out or maybe someone did something to the decedent. Gregor is hoping that the decedent's death is determined to be a "freak accident". Gregor wants to know what happened to the decedent but the investigators are not going to figure it out.

EEEEEEE. Gregor again advised that he thinks it was a "freak accident" and that he thinks the decedent had a blood clotting disorder. Gregor further advised that he believes the decedent may have ingested meth while under the care of Micciolo. The decedent had a bruise on his chest from getting hit with a football the weekend prior.

FFFFFFF. On Thursday, February 17, 2022, at approximately 1200 hours, Dennis placed a phone call to Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

GGGGGGG. The phone call was met with negative results.

HHHHHHH. On Thursday, February 17, 2022, at approximately 1231 hours, Dennis received a phone call from Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

IIIIIII. The conversation yielded negative results for information pertaining to this investigation.

JJJJJJJ. On Tuesday, February 22, 2022, this Affiant was contacted by Dennis in reference to the ongoing investigation and consensual intercept. Dennis advised that Gregor reached out to her and stated he was going to meet with his attorney. Gregor requested to call Dennis afterwards and update her on the case status. It was determined based on the likelihood that the conversation would entail details or other information pertaining to outstanding charges against Gregor that the conversation would be deemed outside the scope of the consensual intercept and Dennis would not respond to the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office to have the phone call recorded.

KKKKKKK. Dennis subsequently sent this Affiant pictures of notes that she took in reference to the conversation with Gregor.

LLLLLLL. In short, Gregor related the following:

MMMMMMM. Gregor believes that the medical examiner may try to tie the death of the decedent to the treadmill incident. Gregor hopes that the death is ruled an accident. Gregor's attorney believes that Gregor will be charged with murder. Gregor told Dennis that he will be sitting in prison for either manslaughter or homicide and that he will have to be in solitary because other inmates will know he is there for killing a kid.

NNNNNNN. On Friday, February 25, 2022, Dennis responded to the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office and provided this Affiant with her notes. The notes were subsequently entered into evidence.

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OOOOOOO. On Friday, February 25, 2022, at approximately 1455 hours, Dennis placed a phone call to Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

PPPPPPP. In short, Gregor related the following:

QOOOQOO. In reference to Dennis providing a statement to the police, Gregor said to be honest. Gregor acknowledged referring to the decedent as the "Michelin Man". Gregor believes that someone will be charged soon. Gregor advised that he would never beat his son. In reference to a post made by Micciolo, Gregor stated that the decedent was kicked in the face while playing soccer which resulted in a cut lip.

RRRRRRR. Gregor referred to messages between him and Micciolo that he provided to his attorney. Gregor stated that he would not take a polygraph based upon advice from his attorney. Gregor advised Dennis to tell her "truth" and further stated that Dennis has no way of knowing whether he or Micciolo is telling the truth. Gregor acknowledged stating that things would have been easier without the decedent or Micciolo around. Gregor wishes he stayed in Baltimore. Gregor stated that the decedent was a very aggressive kid and had emotional disturbance. Gregor further related that he has a copy of the decedent's IEP (Individualized Education Program) as a result of the same.

SSSSSSS. On Monday, February 28, 2022, at approximately 1008 hours, Dennis placed a phone call to Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

TTTTTTT. In short, Gregor related the following:

UUUUUUU. Gregor acknowledged telling Dennis that the decedent was okay when Micciolo dropped him off on April 2, 2021.

VVVVVVV. On Tuesday, March 1, 2022, at 1000 hours, Chief Trial Attorney Michael Weatherstone authorized a consensual intercept for a period of twenty (20) days between Dennis and Gregor.

WWWWWWW. On Thursday, March 3, 2021, this Affiant received the opinion letter of Dr. Thomas Andrew. Dr. Andrew determined the cause of death of the decedent to be **BLUNT IMPACT INJURIES OF THE CHEST AND ABDOMEN WITH LACERATION OF THE HEART, LEFT PULMONARY CONTUSION, LACERATION AND CONTUSION OF THE LIVER** and the manner of death to be **HOMICIDE**. Dr. Andrew further noted in his report that injuries to the decedent are consistent with ongoing abuse over time rather than a single incident.

XXXXXXX. Dr. Andrew also noted that an acute traumatic injury to the heart occurred four (4) to twelve (12) hours prior to the decedent's pronouncement. Additionally, Dr. Andrew found evidence of chronic abuse.

YYYYYYY. On Friday, March 4, 2022, at approximately 1005 hours, Dennis placed a phone call to Gregor. The phone call, which was met with negative results, was recorded via my county issued digital recorder.

ZZZZZZZ. At approximately 1333 hours, Dennis placed a second phone call to Gregor. The phone call was recorded via my county issued digital recorder. In short, the conversation went as follows:

AAAAAAA. In relation to a recent Facebook post by Micciolo, Gregor advised that the police wouldn't tell Micciolo if murder charges were close to being filed out of fear of Gregor leaving the area. When

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asked if he would leave the area, Gregor stated he would not because he does not think anything is going to happen.

BBBBBBBBB. On Monday, March 7, 2022, this Affiant was contacted by Dennis. Dennis provided a screenshot of a conversation between her and Gregor identifying Laura as his girlfriend. This Affiant knows Laura to be Laura Powell. A DMV look-up of Powell yielded a home address of [REDACTED] in Sea Bright, New Jersey. Furthermore, a DMV look-up of Gregor yielded a home address of [REDACTED] in Monroe, New Jersey.

CCCCCCCCC. On Tuesday, March 8, 2022, the abovementioned facts were presented to Chief Trial Attorney Michael Weatherstone and Supervising Assistant Prosecutor Kristin Pressman, in the presence of members of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Homicide Squad and Barnegat Township Police. Chief Trial Attorney Michael Weatherstone subsequently approved the charge of Murder in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:11-3A(1) against Christopher Gregor.
