The Township of Warren received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on April 2, 2024. The official Records Custodian, Cathy Reese received your OPRA request on April 2, 2024. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request was April 12, 2024. However, an extension of time was requested on April 12, 2024 for a April 19, 2024 delivery date. We thank you for your patience.

You requested:

“Emails to and from Township Committee Members, Mayor Victor Sordillo, Depute Mayor Lisa Lontai regarding the Somerset Associates property at 15 Mountainview Road beginning January 2023 to today.”

Please see the attached Vaughn Index for a list of pages redacted and the approved state exception to the OPRA law for those redactions. These records are being transmitted to you via email, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Warren to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
