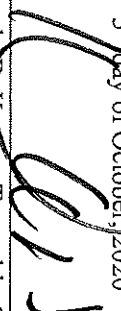
WHEREAS, the Committee has solicited Township residents to serve as members of the advisory committee and a number of residents have volunteered to serve.
