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I responded to [REDACTED] for a report that the neighbor is playing loud music and trying to antagonize the calling party's father.

On arrival, I was waved down by the neighbor, [REDACTED], which is across the street. He explained he did not call the police but arrived home and was approached in his driveway by his neighbor from [REDACTED]. He said the neighbor pulled into the driveway twice and was mad at him, telling him to keep the music down. Then for the last half hour or so, they were yelling at each other, including about fighting each other. [REDACTED] said they did not fight or get physical.

I then spoke to the calling party, [REDACTED], and her father, [REDACTED]. They explained that [REDACTED] will come home with music playing loudly from the car. [REDACTED] went over today to ask him nicely to keep the music down. At some point, [REDACTED] parked his car along the hill, which is not the common place he parks his car, and opened all the doors and started to play the music loudly again. [REDACTED] asked him to turn the music down again.

[REDACTED] advised this is when [REDACTED] started to act out. She showed me short video clips on her phone of [REDACTED] standing near the edge of his property and facing their home. He appeared to be yelling at [REDACTED] and talking about fighting.

I advised [REDACTED] to keep the videos and they could sign complaints if they chose to at the municipal court. I also advised them to avoid [REDACTED] and to call if there were any further problems.

I spoke to [REDACTED] again and advised him to stop playing the music loudly as it appeared he might be purposely trying to bother his neighbors. [REDACTED] was not happy with this and ultimately went inside the residence. I then left the scene.

A short time later, I discovered that [REDACTED] was wanted out of Lebanon Township Police for a [REDACTED] Dispatch confirmed the warrant.

Ptl. Brown and I went back to the residence and detained [REDACTED]. Sgt. Plimpton from the Lebanon Township Police arrived shortly after and took custody of [REDACTED] on their warrant.
