N.J.S.A. 47:1A-9a (states that nothing in OPRA “shall abrogate any exemption of a public record or government record from public access heretofore made pursuant to . . . any other statute [,]” and N.J.S.A. 2C:25-33a (states that “[a]ll records maintained pursuant to [the Domestic Violence Act shall] be confidential and shall not be made available to any individual or institution except as otherwise provided by law[,],” except for certain law enforcement records that can be disclosed to the victim or victim’s legal representative only).
