NEW BUSINESS

Council President provided an update to the public regarding Code Blue, the arrest of a Public Works employee, the number of bilingual police officers employed by the police department, a possible resolution in support of the nurses and a grant given from St. Peter's Hospital.

Danielle Moore thanked the sanitation workers, spoke about racism, sexual assault and violence in the city. Jessica Aquino, Carol Tanzi and John Shi spoke about the nurses' strike and asked the council to support the S304 bill. Mr. Kratovil commented on the closed session not being on the agenda and the rehiring of JT Miller. Mr. Shamy clarified to the public, closed sessions are not required to be on the agenda prior to taking place. Mr. Drulis commented on the rehire of JT Miller. Daniel Alexander spoke about Native American Heritage month and the New Jersey Commission Native American Affairs. April McClous spoke about the safe staffing legislation, plans for George Street and affordable housing. A few other members of the public spoke about supporting the nurses and safe staffing at the hospital. Jess Marigot inquired on R-112342, asking if there was a requirement for a bilingual candidate. Ms. Marigot also spoke in support of the nurses. On a motion regularly made, seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned at 7:09 P.M.
