Re: Open Public Records Act

Dear OPRA Machine:

The Borough of Gibbsboro Records Custodian received your request for records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act (OPRA) on August 20, 2024. Accordingly, the initial seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request under OPRA is August 28, 2024. This response is being provided on the first day after your request.

Your records request was as follows:

A digital copy of the most recently approved memorandum of ALL collective bargaining units with which the township, city, borough, etc., currently holds active agreements.

Please include the most recent contract booklet (signed or unsigned), the most recent memorandum of agreement, salary guides, and any sidebar agreements, if applicable.

A search of our available records shows that the following records respond to your request:

1. Collective Bargaining Agreement Between the Borough of Gibbsboro and the Gibbsboro Police Association, effective 4/14/21 through 12/31/26, amended 5/14/24

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Gibbsboro to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
