A response to your request is as follows:

Please be advised the Westfield Building (Construction) Department, Office of Administration, and Westfield Health Department conducted a search and have no records responsive to your request for “Communication(s) (i: emails, letters, memorandums) received by and in the possession of the Township of Westfield, its Construction Department and/or its officials/employees from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection advising to deny and/or stop accepting and/or issuing construction permits to Sam Bonaccorso and Sons LLC, Salvatore Bonaccorso or Christian Cueto.”

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Westfield to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
