As you know, OSC's procurement review authority is focused on whether the process and procurement documents comply with applicable law. In accordance with OSC's procurement review authority, OSC does not object to the release and/or advertisement of the procurement documents, with each document in the final form as attached hereto, or as previously finalized with no remaining OSC comments. Gloucester Township may proceed with these documents.

OSC's determination with regard to compliance of the procurement documents is not intended to constitute OSC's approval of the procurement process, and OSC makes no findings as to the procurement process at this point. Gloucester Township will be expected to continue to cooperate with OSC by providing information and responding to inquiries throughout the procurement process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:15C-14.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:15C-10, within 20 days of award of a contract, contracting units shall provide OSC with notice of the award on the form for "CONTRACT COMPLIANCE FORM B2 POST-
